

United States Attacking Growing Hazard Of Radiation From Fallout, Industrial Use

Washington — The United States is attacking on various fronts the growing worldwide hazard from man-made radiation caused by fallout and industrial uses of atomic energy.

The President in August issued an executive order establishing a new Federal Radiation Council. Congress passed, during the last week of the session, a bill establishing the Council as a statutory body. The Council is expected to set up new radiation protection standards. The National Advisory Committee on Radiation reported to the U.S. Surgeon General in March that because of the lack of much basic scientific data, it is currently very difficult, if not impossible, to determine how much radiation we can be exposed to without injury.

Radiation hazards are increasing because of increased use of X-rays, ever-widening uses of atomic energy, accumulated industrial waste and debris, and fallout from nuclear weapons testing.

Radiation Defined
Radiation is the release of atomic energy which damages many substances. It occurs in many forms, and cannot be seen or felt. Its damage is cumulative. Radiation-induced disease often does not show up until years after the damage was suffered. It is a cause of cancer, particularly of the bones, blood and lungs. Cells of the reproductive system, lymph glands and bone marrow are particularly sensitive to radiation. By attacking the reproductive cells controlling heredity, it can cause an increase in stillbirths, deformities and abnormalities in future generations.

From the standpoint of heredity, all radiation is harmful. Children and pregnant women are particularly sensitive to radiation.

The horror of nuclear war gripped the world in 1945 when the United States dropped two atomic bombs on Hiroshima and Nagasaki, Japan. The bombs contained 40,000 tons of deadly radioactive fission. Some 106,000 Japanese were killed, and 110,000 were injured from blast, burns and radiation. Deaths from the delayed effects of radiation have occurred since then.

Nuclear War Effects
Nuclear war, under modern-day conditions, would kill

many millions of people in the nations under all-out attack and would virtually immobilize their great cities. This was pointed out by Joint Atomic Energy Committee hearings held in June.

The Committee assumed that 263 nuclear bombs, with a total yield of 1,446 megatons, were dropped in a one-day mid-October attack on

224 cities and military bases located in every state of the union. A one megaton nuclear bomb has the explosive energy equivalent of one million tons of TNT. It also assumed that half of the energy yield of the bombs was fission, the primary source of radioactive fallout.

The Committee concluded that such an attack would

cost the lives of about 25 percent of the U.S. population; that nearly 50 million Americans would be killed and 20 million more would sustain serious though non-fatal injuries. It also concluded that fallout from the bombs would account for 25 percent of the deaths and more than half of the injuries.

Tests Halting
World-wide fear of fallout has led to a halt in nuclear weapons testing. No tests have been conducted by the three nuclear powers, the United States, the United Kingdom and the Soviet Union, since Nov. 3, 1958.

The Joint Atomic Energy Committee concluded that the fallout alone from nuclear bomb testing, on the same pattern it has been done for the past five years, could constitute a hazard to the world's population within the next two generations. But fallout is a lesser man-made hazard than other types of radiation.

By the age of 30 a man has been exposed to about four rems from radiation from the atmosphere and five rems from X-rays and other forms of medical radiation. A rem is a unit of measuring a dose of exposure to all types of radiation in relation to its biological effect on man. It is currently believed that radiation exposure should not be more than 10 rems as the average per capita dose at the age of 30. All other types of radiation, including fallout, account for a fraction of that.

But this indicates that all radiation hazards must be kept as low as possible. **Hazards Increasing**
Radiation hazards to the general public will increase in future years from radioactive waste and from water pollution. Highly radioactive waste in this country is expected to increase from 65 million gallons, as of today, to 1 billion gallons in year 2,000. Burial in the ocean appears to some to be an obvious graveyard for such waste. But little is known of its effects on sea food. So the state of Texas and the cities of Houston and Galveston have been putting up a two-year battle to try to keep the Atomic Energy Commission from dumping low-grade radioactive waste in the deep water of the Gulf of Mexico.
