

Medford Officials Plan to Attend League Meeting

A new proposed model city ordinance for transportation and storage of explosives will be one of the subjects at the annual meeting of the League of Oregon Cities Oct. 18 to Oct. 21 in Port and, according to the agenda. All of Medford's department heads plan to attend.

The model ordinance was developed following requests of several Oregon cities after the Roseburg disaster. Some of the cities indicated they had adopted a suggested ordinance of the National Fire Protection association but do not consider it entirely adequate.

The league office has also developed a suggested ordinance for cities to establish a civil service system for firemen. A law enacted by the 1959 state legislature requires that Oregon cities having, besides the chief, four or more full-time firemen establish civil service systems.

Personnel Covered
Fire department personnel covered by the act must be subject to civil service by Sept. 1, 1960. Medford has had such an ordinance since 1936 which was approved at an election.

Registration opens Sunday, Oct. 18, followed by a city managers' luncheon and business meeting and a get-acquainted reception at 5:30 p.m.

Two highlights of the convention will be addresses by John F. Kennedy, U.S. senator from Massachusetts on Tuesday, and Mayor Donald Hummel, Tucson, Ariz., a member of the American Municipal association board of directors Tuesday evening.
