The car, driven by Eugene C. Smith, 1322 West Harvard ave., Roseburg, in which the Cardwells were riding, was northbound on Old Stage rd. when it went onto a shoulder and over an embankment before hitting a fence. Merrill Cardwell was thrown against the windshield and broke it, police said.

The drive, sponsored annually by the Medford Council of United Church Women and the Medford Ministerial association, is still in need of clothing with at least six months wear left in them.

A variety of items will be accepted but officials reminded residents that the clothing is baled when shipped. Each church's contributions should be put into cartons, tied securely, and labeled with the name of the church and its address.

Deliver them to First Methodist church, Main st. and Laurel ave.; Eastwood Baptist church, North Keeneway ave. at Ridgeway dr.; or First Assembly of God, 1108 West Main st. to be left on the porch of the annex.

Eight cents per pound is needed to cover the cost of overseas shipment and each church will receive a statement from the Church World Service, Modesto, Calif. Cash contributions are also acceptable.

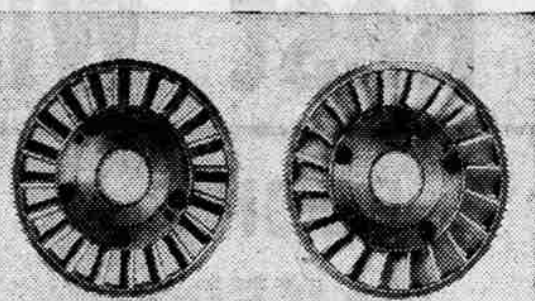
