Satellite, Missile Successes Bring Scientific Smiles

Cape Canaveral, Fla.—(UPI)—A complex earth satellite leaped into orbit and two big missiles soared hundreds of miles Tuesday in one of America's most dazzling assaults to date on space and its fringes.

The 91.5-pound satellite, launched by a 60-ton Juno II rocket, was sandwiched be-

tween successful edge-of-space shots by a Thor IRBM and an air-launched ballistic missile (ALBM).

The ALBM was fired from a B-47 bomber toward the general direction of the Explorer VI "Paddlewheel" satellite as the moonlet swung to within 150 miles of earth, and the Thor sped about 1,700 miles downrange.

Successes Bring Smiles

The trio of successes brought wide smiles to U.S. scientists and missilemen, who still have not recovered from the demoralizing effects of the Russian moonrocks, Luniks II and III.

"We needed these bad—and we got them," said one.

The "kitchen sink" satellite, a complicated ball of seven experiments designed to show man more about the workings of the near and far universe, was the star of the day with its Juno II launcher. It was a far cry from the blow-up of a similar attempt July 16.

To Solve Mysteries

This time, the 76-foot-long vehicle fired successfully through all four stages and sent the moonlet whirling into orbit carrying it to within 664 miles of earth at apogee and 348 miles at perigee. It is expected to orbit about 20 years.

Two transmitters, which will be cut off automatically exactly one year from Tuesday, are now transmitting noises "like a flying bagpipe" to its 20 tracking stations and hundreds of "bystanding" radio amateurs around the world.

When translated, the "bagpipe" squeals and squalls may solve more riddles of the universe, including mysteries about earth's weather.

Three Hunters Appear In Justice Court

Gold Hill — Three hunters charged with violating state hunting laws forfeited bail or paid fines in justice court here during the past week, according to Justice of the Peace Dale Collins.

Two forfeiting \$30 were Lonnie McCoy Jones and Lonnie William Jones, both of Riddle and both charged with failure to tag deer properly. Juanita Hilkey, of Upper River rd., Gold Hill, appeared in court and paid \$14.50 for illegal possession of venison, Collins reported.

Benefit Dance Set Saturday

A dance for high school and junior high school students is being sponsored as a United Medford Crusade special event by the city of Medford Saturday night according to Eugene Garner of the UMC special events committee.

The "record hop" dance is scheduled at the National Guard Armory on South Pacific highway from 8 to 11 p.m., with proceeds to go to the UMC. Students from Ashland or Grants Pass who wish to designate their admission payments for their local fund drives in those communities may do so, Garner added.

Only \$25 is being charged for rental of the armory, Garner reported. Admission is 50 cents for stags and 75 cents for couples.

He explained that students from all parts of the Rogue valley are invited, the only stipulation being that they must show a student body ticket, or be escorted by someone with such a ticket, in order to be admitted.

Dance contests are planned, Garner said. Soft drinks will be available. Chaperones will attend and the grounds will be patrolled, he continued.

Garner pointed out that the event is being sponsored by the city's parks and recreation department since the UMC itself cannot sponsor the special event.
