

Macmillan Picks Defense Head In Reshuffle

London—(AP)—Prime Minister Harold Macmillan completed a broad reshuffle of his government Wednesday including appointment of a new defense minister.

Harold Watkinson, minister of transport in Macmillan's last cabinet, was given the defense post.

He replaced Duncan Sandys, son-in-law of Sir Winston Churchill who was transferred to the new job of minister of aviation.

The three top cabinet jobs were untouched.

Home Secretary Richard A. Butler, Foreign Secretary Selwyn Lloyd, and Chancellor of the Exchequer Derick Heathcoat Amory kept their jobs.

Secretary Resigns

Colonial Secretary Alan Lennox-Boyd, who had been sharply criticized for the Cyprus revolt, Nyasaland disorders and the Hola prison camp massacre in Kenya, resigned, it was announced.

He was replaced by former Minister of Labor Iain MacLeod.

Simultaneous with the Cabinet reshuffle, Macmillan ordered a top priority diplomatic drive to tighten Britain's relations with its continental neighbors as a prelude to a possible early East-West summit meeting.

Government sources said Macmillan was confident that a summit meeting can be held by December, or by January at the latest.

Surgery Survival Chances Improve

New York (Science Service)—The more than 10,000,000 persons undergoing surgery this year stand a much better chance of surviving than did patients 25 years ago.

In one large hospital the surgical mortality during 1945-54 was 43 per cent below that of the period 1925-34, the Metropolitan Life Insurance company reports here.

The risk of operation has decreased markedly, the insurance company statistics show, even while the scope of surgery has broadened. New and improved surgical techniques as well as better diagnosis and selection of patients eligible for surgery, advances in anesthesiology and the control of infections are said to be responsible for the reduced number of surgery deaths.

Striking reductions in mortality associated with some specific operations include gall bladder, thyroid, duodenal ulcer operations and esophagectomy in cancer.

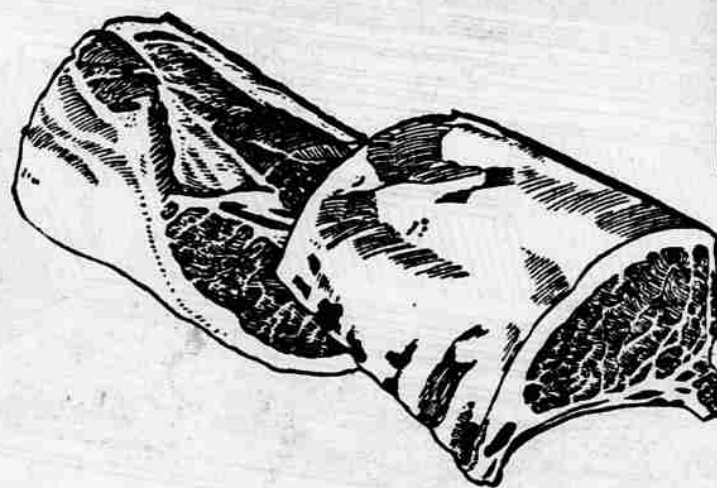
