

### Food Buys Listed

Washington —UPI— Shoppers this week end will find pork, beef and poultry in excellent supply with prices favorable to the family food budget.

Vegetable bins offer a good variety, too. Among these are potatoes and sweet potatoes, onions, cabbage, spinach, cauliflower, tomatoes and carrots.

The leading fruits offered today, and representing excellent values, are apples, pears, oranges, grapefruit, lemons, grapes and avocados.

In the fish line, plentiful include shrimp, fish sticks, and canned tuna.

These are the week-end's best values from a national standpoint. Now, here's a closer look at plentiful foods in the West.

Arizona, California, Idaho, Montana, Nevada, Oregon, Utah, Washington, Wyoming.

Shoppers will find lower priced pork, eggs, fryer chickens and apples in most markets this week. Fresh pork loins are down 2 to 3 cents a pound in most markets, and other pork cuts are slightly weaker in price. Beef is in ample supply, and some cuts are down 2 to 3 cents a pound in California markets. Calif. veal and lamb are mostly unchanged in price.

Supplies of eggs, particularly the large size, are plentiful. Large eggs are mostly 2 to 3 cents a dozen cheaper this week, and they are down as much as 4 to 6 cents a dozen in the Los Angeles area.

Ample supplies of ready-to-cook fryer chickens are 1 to 2 cents a pound lower than a week ago in most markets, and ready-to-cook tom turkeys are priced slightly lower in California markets. Butter is in ample supply and unchanged in price.

Fall varieties of apples are in plentiful supply and lower in price. Other fresh fruit and vegetable plentiful include grapes, pears, cauliflower, lettuce, tomatoes, cabbage and dry yellow onions. In good supply are avocados, grapefruit, lemons, Valencia oranges, potatoes, squash, spinach and sweet potatoes.

In fish, best buys include salmon, halibut, rockfish, flounder and sablefish.

### Concert Series To Open Soon

Portland — Portland Symphony orchestra will open its 1959-60 season on October 26 at the Civic Auditorium when Conductor Piero Bellugi will make his Portland public debut.

Director Bellugi arrives in Portland on October 15 from Italy where he conducted a series of concerts and incidentally met several composers of works scheduled to be played this season in Portland.

The 80-piece orchestra is complete and ready for the season, busily studying scores awaiting the conductor's return. James Matheson, new personnel manager, reports all first chair players except one have signed on for the season, and the ranks of the orchestra show little turnover for such a large organization.

Programmed for opening night are Rossini's Overture to "Le Gazza Ladra," Beethoven's "Seventh Symphony," and three different composers' interpretations of the celebrated lovers theme, "Romeo and Juliet." Scores by Prokofiev, Berlioz and Tchaikovsky are included in this group.

Season tickets for both the regular 12-concert season at the auditorium and the new Tuesday night 6-concert series at the Oriental Theatre are on sale at the Symphony office in the Park building in Portland.

Opening night crowds are invited to attend a reception following the concert which will honor the new conductor and his wife.
