Twins Said No Longer in Danger

Portland — (UPI) — The University of Oregon Medical School hospital here announced today that the Stubblefield twins of Parma, Idaho, have survived the surgery 11 days ago which separated them.

A spokesman said that if either Denett or Jeanett Stubblefield should succumb now, it would not be as a result of the delicate operation. Their conditions are still considered critical.

The 3½ month old girls were born prematurely as Siamese twins June 29 at Nysa, Ore., to Mrs. James Stubblefield.

Surgery performed here by a team of experts Oct. 6 parted the tots and a medical bulletin afterward stated the operation "worked quite well." The girls were born joined extensively from the breastbone to the navel. They also had adjoining heart sacs and livers.

Jeanett was reported near death several times but made it through each crisis and her stronger sister has showed daily improvement since the surgery.

Shortage of Steel Curbs Production of 1960 Automobiles

Detroit — (UPI) — Steel shortages slowed the assembly lines of 1960 model car production for the first time today and boosted layoffs in General Motors to the 60,000 mark.

The figure represented close to 20 per cent of GM's total production force of 330,000.

At the same time, the auto industry reported near record sales of its new models, putting a tight squeeze on the availability of new cars.

Dealer Sales High

Ward's Automotive Reports, statistical agency for the auto industry, reported dealers sold more cars in the first 10 days of this month than in any other new model introduction period since record smashing 1955.

But industry enthusiasm for the fast selling pace was tempered by the steady encroachment of steel shortages on ability of the manufacturers to keep turning them out.

GM made a nationwide survey of its parts, accessories and assembly plants and announced total layoffs due to steel shortages numbered 60,000 as of close of business today.

That figure already included one Chevrolet final assembly plant, and another was due to be hit next week. Two thirds of the workers at the Chevrolet assembly plant in Janesville, Wis., were scheduled to be laid off next Tuesday because of the steel strike.

Heaviest in Pontiac History

Pontiac division of GM reported its sales during the first 10 days of this month were the heaviest in the division's history. Oldsmobile reported sales were up 80 per cent over last year while Studebaker-Packard reported it delivered more cars to its dealers than it had at any time in the last five years.

American Motors reported sales up 18 per cent over last year while Chrysler Corp. reported Imperial sales were double those of a year ago. Chrysler's Dodge division reported it was unable to meet the demands of its customers.

Complaint Seeks Payment of Money

A complaint has been filed in circuit court by Zelma C. Lamb, Ashland, against William R. Ritchie Jr., Crescent City, Calif., asking payment of money paid by the plaintiff for the defendant.

According to the complaint, Zelma Lamb paid the clerk of the U. S. district court on Oct. 13, for the St. Paul Fire and Marine Insurance company, for and on behalf of defendant, \$37,333.72.

The plaintiff stated that defendant has refused to pay any part of the sum and requests judgment of the full amount plus 6 per cent interest.

Philadelphia — (UPI) — The body of Mario Lanza, 38, will lie tonight in a South Philadelphia funeral home nearby where the film and opera star was born and raised.

A solemn requiem mass will be sung Saturday at the Church of St. Mary Magdalen, of which the singer once was a parishioner.

Lanza's body was flown from Rome, where the tenor suffered a fatal heart attack Oct. 7.

He will be buried in Los Angeles in a private mausoleum at Forest Lawn cemetery.

Lanza's wife and four children are still in Rome closing their affairs before moving to Los Angeles, where they will make their home.

Traffic Claims Two in Portland

Milwaukie Votes Improvement Bonds

There are 938 candidates for the job. There would have been 952, but the local election commission disqualified 14 because their papers were not in order.

Some of the candidates can not even count on their relatives to vote for them. In one family, a son is running against his father, mother, grandfather and grandmother.

Compromise Seen On Proposed Dunes Park Bill

Salem — (UPI) — Sen. Richard Neuberger, Gov. Mark Hatfield and the governor's committee on Natural Resources appeared today to be heading towards a compromise on the proposed Oregon dunes national park.

Neuberger said that by Oct. 27 he will submit to Hatfield a revised bill which will include changes based on recent congressional hearings in Reedsport and Florence.

The governor said he would then submit the revised bill to the Natural Resources Committee for study and report their reaction back to Neuberger.

Wants Revised Bill

The Democratic senator said he wants to have his revised bill ready for consideration when congressional hearings conducted by Rep. Grace Pflast (D-Idaho) resume Oct. 31.

Revisions in the bill probably will include recommendations that the proposed park area extend south of Reedsport to Tenmile creek and include the Umpqua Light-house state park. The Jesse Honeyman state park and the Sea Lions caves probably would be excluded in the new bill.

The area south of Reedsport includes some spectacular high dunes.
