

### Soviet Housewives Enthusiastic Over Premier's Decree

Moscow - (UPI) - Russian housewives reacted enthusiastically to a move by Premier Nikita Khrushchev that would step up production and lower prices of refrigerators, vacuum cleaners and other consumer goods.

A decree signed by Khrushchev was aimed at doubling or tripling Soviet production of refrigerators, sewing machines, bicycles, television and radio sets, furniture, vacuum cleaners and many other goods.

The decree was issued shortly after Khrushchev's barnstorming tour of the United States. It was designed to make good on his pledge at last February's Communist Party congress to ease the housewives' lot by boosting production, improving the quality, expanding the variety and cutting the prices of consumer items.

The decree concerned itself even with unprecedented frills.

For example, Khrushchev ordered modern, eye-pleasing lampshades, porcelain musical clocks, white enamel kitchenware and stain removers for woollens, silk and cotton fabrics.

The Soviet Premier, at the same time, told a group of visiting women from Ryazan yesterday that "we will produce all the cars we need and if you wish you will be able to travel by car." But he warned them against being impressed with the "superficial glitter" in shining automobiles.

**Popular Demands**  
Soviet authorities were now responding to a popular demand for more rational distribution of goods, better packaging, more efficient home appliances and improved designing of household goods.

In past year, the Soviet consumer was happy to buy anything - that appeared in the shops, regardless of quality. He is now becoming choosier.

For years, Soviet newspapers have been carrying complaints against pairs of shoes that didn't match, clothes that didn't fit and toilets that wouldn't flush.

Such complaints have become more rare as the market has changed from a seller's to a buyer's market.

Heavy industry still remains the "foundation of foundations" of the Soviet economy. The new decrees calling for a sharp rise in consumer goods production does not provide for a cutback in capital investment or in the goals of heavy industry.

### Thermometer Aids In Cancer Fight

Rye, N.Y. - (UPI) - The fight against cancer is being aided by what is probably the world's most constant thermometer at the new Walker Laboratory of the Sloan-Kettering Institute here.

The thermometer, which is guarded by a system of thermostats more than 100 times more sensitive than the human body, registers the temperature of a room which is not allowed to vary more than two degrees from 74 degrees Fahrenheit.

The thermostats, which are equipped with alarms and are controlled by a "data center" developed for the laboratory by the Minneapolis-Honeywell Regulator Co., safeguard the institute's priceless colony of research animals.

### Young Americans Compete for Awards

New York - (UPI) - More than 160,000 young Americans are expected to compete in the 1960 Scholastic Writing Awards - the world's largest literary competition for secondary school students.

Sponsored by the Sheaffer Pen Co. and conducted by Scholastic Magazines, the event offers cash prizes totaling \$3,675, plus pens and gold keys, for winning entries in several classifications including short story, poetry, essay and dramatic script.

Juries of outstanding authors and educators will select the winning manuscripts when the contest ends on March 1, 1960.

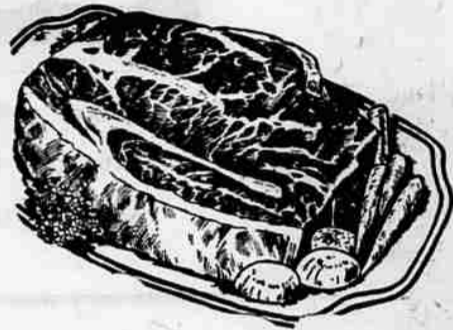
