Portland—UPI—A brief opposing a civil aeronautics board examiner's recommendation that Northwest Airlines be given an exclusive certificate to provide air service between Portland and Honolulu was filed with the CAB by four local agencies Wednesday.

The brief urged the CAB to reverse the examiner's finding and to certify both Pan American World Airways and Northwest Orient Airlines to provide competitive air service over the route.

It was filed by the Port of Portland, the Chamber of Commerce, the city of Portland and the local Freight Traffic association.
