

### Flynn Estate Stirs a Battle

New York — (UPI) — A fight brewed today over the estate of actor Errol Flynn, whose will was filed for probate here Wednesday.

The will, dated April 27, 1954, left most of his estate to his widow, Mrs. Patrice Wyome Flynn, with specific bequests to his children and parents.

In Hollywood, his former wife, Mrs. Nora Haynes, said Flynn had told her there was another will dated some time in 1957 in which he left everything to his children and parents. She said she planned to consult an attorney to protect the interests of her two daughters by Flynn.

Belvin Belli, San Francisco attorney representing Beverly Aadland, Flynn's 17-year-old companion for the past year, said he was amazed that no provision had been made for his client. He said he knew Flynn wanted to provide for Beverly and Belli and he would do something about it.

Flynn and his widow had been separated for some time while he traveled to Europe and the Caribbean with Beverly.

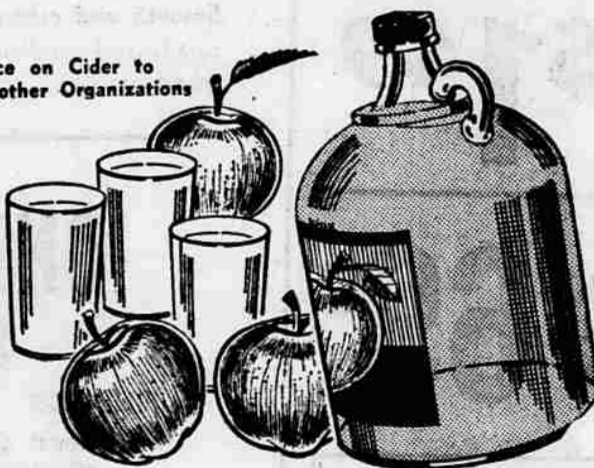
