**The Family Council**

Editor's Note: The Family Council consists of a Judge, a psychiatrist, three clergymen, a newspaper editor, a woman's editor and two writers. Each article is a summary of an actual case history. The Council reports on problems that have been dealt with by responsible agencies and counselors.

**Mrs. H. M. - Ellen should send Bruce to boarding school.**  
Ellen J. - He would feel that I don't want him.

**Mrs. H. M. - I am trying to help my daughter who is a widow in her 30's.**  
Her husband died four years ago leaving a little boy of 5. Ellen and her son are now living with me and my husband.

**My husband is elderly and not too well so he can't act as a father to the boy.**  
Ellen keeps herself out trying to play baseball with him and she goes to all kinds of sports events she hates. The boy isn't happy about it either. He complains of being the only kid who goes with his mother.

**Ellen's husband left her well fixed financially.**  
She can send the boy to boarding school where he'll be in a masculine atmosphere. I feel she should take a job and concentrate on marrying again. She is certainly too young to go on alone.

**Ellen J. - It is bad enough my son has to do without a father, he doesn't have to be without a mother too.**  
If I were to send Bruce to boarding school he might feel that I don't want him. His father's death made him feel very insecure. He has certain nervous tics that developed shortly afterward.

**I feel that all I can do is my best to act as a mother and father to Bruce.**  
I hope to marry again, but it may not be for some time. In the meantime Bruce becomes terribly attached to any man I go out with and is later disappointed if the man stops coming around.

**I would love to take a job, but I can't burden my mother with the responsibility for Bruce.**  
He is really too much for her. It is awfully hard going on like this, but I must.

**The Council: Ellen should be aware children are seldom fooled about important matters like their parent's real feelings.**  
This is just one reason why she should not try to falsify issues in relation to her son. The other reason is simply that she has a right and a need to strive for her own happiness. If she denies this she will turn resentful and bitter and her son will certainly suffer the consequences.

**It is fairly evident that Ellen feels terribly burdened at present by her attempt to play both mother and father to Bruce.**  
The boy is no doubt aware of this. He would not be likely to object to going
