Bulletin Explains Smoking Policy

Medford school administrators have prepared a bulletin explaining the district's policy and the provisions of law regarding the use of tobacco on or near school premises.

The bulletin will be distributed in Medford's two junior high schools as well as the high school, officials said.

Administrators noted that "previous school policy directed that no student may smoke or be in possession of tobacco within three blocks of school." The policy, they said, is continued in view of the current law.

Students over 18 years old may legally be in possession of tobacco, the administration noted, but "shall not display or furnish it to minors under 18 years of age and shall not smoke within three blocks of the school."

The bulletin reviews the health aspect of tobacco and quotes recent legislation prohibiting persons under 18 years old from smoking. Administrators noted that the Jackson county district attorney has directed all law enforcement agencies in the county to enforce the new law.

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INSTALLMENT BUYING UP

Moscow - (UPI) - Installment buying is becoming increasingly popular in urban areas of the Russian republic of the Soviet Union, the Soviet news agency Tass reported Friday. It said a wide variety of goods are available, including furs, motor scooters, bicycles, boat motors, cameras, kitchen appliances and radios and that payments can be made over a period of six to 12 months.
