The Medical Roundup

Paget's Disease of the Bones

Many people ask me what they are to do about the Paget's disease of their bones, which has perhaps been discovered accidentally during an x-ray examination made for something else. In this disease some bones become thickened.

I was just reading an interesting article on the subject by Dr. Paul C. Hodges, an eminent teacher of x-ray work in Chicago. He has found Paget's disease—usually accidentally—in about one in 1,000 patients x-rayed by him for various conditions. The most common sites of involvement have been the spinal vertebrae, the pelvis, skull, long thigh bones, the main bone in the leg below the knee, and the bone in the upper arm.

Some of the middle-aged persons who have Paget's disease complain of pain, but many have no symptoms. In rare cases in which there are marked changes in the thigh and leg bones, there can develop a decided bowing of the legs. In some people the disease remains for a lifetime in a single bone. Occasionally, a markedly affected bone breaks, or cracks. Every so often the person is found to have more than the usual

a amount of arteriosclerosis; also, he may have much osteoarthritis—a hardening of the bone of the skull about the ears, which is commonly associated with deafness.

Unfortunately, no one seems to know just what produces Paget's disease, and hence there is no good treatment. In acute cases, an affected leg will feel warm to the touch, indicating that there is some inflammation. Fortunately, in many cases, the disease never causes much trouble.

Psychiatry in Russia

Dr. George Serban, of Elmhurst, N.Y., reports in the Journal of the American Medical Association that in Russia, if a person develops a neurosis or psychosis, a psychiatrist will dare suggest that it is due to environmental conditions, because in a perfect socialist state, the conditions are always perfect. To criticize them would be treasonous.

Dr. Serban tells of a young Russian woman who, in college, fell deeply in love with an Army officer and married him. When she graduated, some callous bureaucrats sent her to work in a plant hundreds of miles from her home and her husband. There, naturally, she became so desperately unhappy that she became depressed, and the quality of her work became unsatisfactory.

Because she could not quit her job—that would have made of her a saboteur—she soon was desirous of taking the only way out—by suicide. According to the Russian story, she was cured by a psychiatrist who convinced her that she should be very happy because it is so much better to work for the good of the State than for one's own good! She learned that "collectivity" is immensely more important than anyone's heart's desires. And so she was cured. "She had solved her personal problem in accordance with the official instructions." I imagine that then she did not have to be shot! Wouldn't it be wonderful to be a psychiatrist in Russia where one could say to a patient, "Get well, or else."

Rockefeller Calls For Nuclear Tests

New York—Gov. Nelson A. Rockefeller Sunday night called for resumption of nuclear weapons testing.

Rockefeller's position put him at odds with apparent administration policy and with the position of many leading nuclear scientists.

"I think that we cannot afford to fall behind in the advanced techniques of the use of nuclear material," Rockefeller said on the television program "Youth Wants to Know."

He discounted the danger from nuclear fallout, but urged that testing be done underground to reduce the possibility of contaminating the air with fallout.

The Republican governor's statement came two days before the scheduled resumption of discussions in Geneva between the United States Great Britain and the Soviet Union on a treaty to end nuclear weapons testing permanently.

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
