The authors answer such questions as "should a mother of three children go to work to help support the family? How should a divorced woman try to explain to her children how it came about that their father left them, and perhaps failed to provide adequately for their support? How can a father explain to his children why their mother walked off

Bath, England—UPI—A local government surveying committee recommended Monday that all holes in the road should be labeled so that the public knows which hole belongs to who.

Thus every time the gas board, the electricity board or the sewer people gouge up a road, Berry said, "these holes should be labeled to let people know what job is being carried out and who is doing it."
