City Police Take Part in Program On Safety in City

Sixteen Medford city police officers are participating in the annual school safety lectures at the schools. Capt. Clyde Fichtner announced this week.

All of the Medford schools through junior high school are included in the program. The talks, on bicycle and pedestrian safety, also stress that children should not accept rides, candy, or money from strangers.

They also explain, particularly to the lower grades, the duties of police officers, and what to do in cases where a stranger attempts to entice them.

Fichtner reported that this is the fifth year for the program with the largest number of participating officers. Majority of the officers give their own time to the program.

Project of Department

Although it has been a project of the city police department for a number of years, the program was only recently expanded so that the officers could speak to the individual classes. Only on the junior high school level is the talk given in a general assembly.

The police officers spoke at Roosevelt school Monday and will be at the other schools Nov. 12, 13, 16, and 18. Schools include Lincoln, Washington, Jefferson, Jackson, Wilson, Hoover, Lone Pine, Howard, and St. Mary's. Patrolman Berl Stephens talks at both junior high schools, it was reported.

Other Officers

Other officers who participate in the program include Lt. Jack McMillan, Sgts. Raymond Seely and Larry Tusow, and Patrolmen Robert Allen, Duane Franklin, Robert Wright, George Lucas, Dennis Perkins, Jack Sanders, Tom Furnas, Gene Dupuy, Frank Elson, and Milton Hanson.

Distributed to the nearly 1,300 first and second graders by the officers is an outline drawing suitable for coloring which reminds the children not to accept gifts or rides from strangers.

The drawing is made available to the local department by the federal bureau of investigation without cost.

Dean Sayre carefully noted that the gargoyle project is not a contest and no prizes are to be offered. The only satisfaction, should your model be picked, would be that your work would be carved into the stone fabric of the cathedral "to remain there through the ages."

Gargoyles are ornamental water spouts that throw water from the roof gutters high up on the cathedral walls. In medieval days they were put on cathedrals to represent evil spirits and to remind passersby of the threats of the Devil and the safety of the church.
