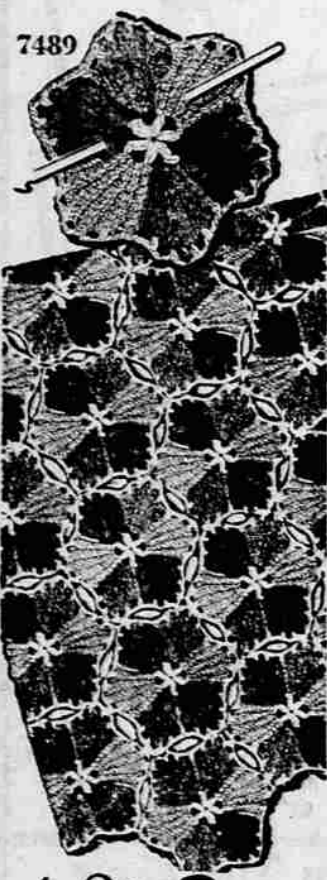
Prospect Lions club held its annual turkey dinner Wednesday at Beckie's cafe, the honored guests being the wives of Lion members.
