Large Lymph Nodes

Many people ask why they, or perhaps their children, have large lymph nodes, perhaps in the side of the neck. I cannot guess. The thing for them to do is to see a physician who should then make several tests. If the enlargement has come recently, it may be due purely to "a bit of flu" or an infectious mononucleosis (what is sometimes called glandular fever). This is a disease which commonly causes distress for a few months and then usually goes away. It seldom leads to anything serious. It can be diagnosed, usually, when an expert looks at the blood.

smears, or perhaps makes a test for the so-called heterophile antibody.

The expert will want quickly to see what the red-blood sedimentation rate is because if it is low, that will tend to rule out the few serious troubles, such as Hodgkin's disease, which is a cancer-like trouble. Often, when the doctor has reason to suspect serious trouble, he will cut out one of the nodes and have it examined under the microscope by an expert pathologist. It must be examined by an expert because, if he isn't able, he can make a mistake in diagnosis.

X-Rays of Chest

X-ray films should be made of the chest to see if there are enlarged lymph nodes there. If they are there and also in the armpits and groins, the outlook is not so good. Sometimes, with Hodgkin's disease, the patient has a little fever, which goes up and down, and sometimes his skin itches. Usually, if he is seen early, x-ray treatment will give relief for several years. We will hope that by the time the disease comes back, there will be some good drug or drugs that will cure it. Hopeful is the report by some men that a few of their patients have apparently been entirely cured of Hodgkin's disease, because they have gone now for many years without trouble. Another disease that will be ruled out by a careful study of the blood is leukemia. Fortunately, today, tuberculosis of the glands of the neck has largely disappeared.

Large Glands

It used to be common. Rarely, one will see a large gland in the neck which contains scattered cancer, perhaps from a growth in the back of the nose, or in one of the linings of the cranial (skull) cavity, or in the stomach, or in the thyroid gland. Sometimes young people with a bad dandruff have large nodes down each side of the neck. Some people tend to get large glands whenever they have a virus infection.

SIGN TAX TREATY
