

B-58 Bomber Averages 1,260 Miles Per Hour

Fort Worth, Tex. — (UPI) — An Air Force B-58 Hustler bomber streaked from Seattle, Wash., to Fort Worth, a distance of 1,680 statute miles, in 80 minutes — an average of 1,260 miles an hour.

Russians Aim at Doubling Oil Production by '65

Chicago (Science Service) — The Russians, on the basis of large new oil discoveries, are aiming at a crude oil production in 1965 that would be about double the output level during the first nine months of this year.

If they achieve this goal, the American Petroleum Institute was told here today, their production may outstrip their low per capita consumption and provide a sizeable surplus for export to the Free World.

Production Increased
This surplus, reported Theodore Shabad, Russian affairs specialist of the foreign news section of the New York Times, could amount to a doubling of the current 200,000 barrels per day that are being shipped to countries of the Free World.

During the past 10 years, the Soviet oil industry has been increasing its crude oil production at an average annual rate of 15 per cent. Output in barrels per day rose from an average of 758,000 in 1950 to an average of 2,500,000 in the first nine months of 1959.

How much oil Russia will be able to export, Shabad said, depends on the success of present plans to expand domestic production, the efforts made to expand domestic consumption through improvement of the standard of living, and the extent to which Russia will use oil exports as a political-economic policy weapon.

Could Approach Goal
Shabad said he believed the Russians could reach, or at least closely approach, their 1965 goal, which would mean a production of about 4,500,000 barrels a day. However, while large plans are being made for using more oil in internal industry and transportation, there is no intention of raising per capita consumption by the average Soviet citizen for automobiles or oil heating of homes.

He also pointed out that Russia, with its state-controlled economy, can assign export quotas arbitrarily without regard to domestic market conditions or the economics of cost.

Wearing of Clothes Declared Help To Evolution of Beauty

New York (Science Service) — Women have prettier faces and men are brainier today than in the dawn of man's existence.

This evolutionary change is attributed to the wearing of clothes, by Lawrence Langner, founder of the Theater Guild, in his new book "The Importance of Wearing Clothes."

Langner is also an international patent attorney and until recently secretary of the U.S. National Inventors Council.

The way that clothing can influence the course of evolution is explained by Langner this way:
As women covered up their bodies, man's attention was directed more toward the face, and upper part of a woman's body. A pretty face, beautiful hair and breasts became the first attributes to attract the male. Since the more attractive women, according to the existing standards, were primarily selected as mates, the whole racial strain has improved in good looks.

Brain Power Emphasis
But of far greater importance Langner sees the increasing emphasis which was placed on a man's brain power as the men covered up their bodies. One important result of the wearing of clothes in cooler climates was that the muscles, or brawn, became hidden. Physical power could not be as easily displayed as a dominant characteristic, and this gave a better chance to men with physically inferior bodies who could cover up their muscular inferiority with clothes and gain power in society and win the females by the use of their minds. In this way racial progress from "brawn to brains" took place over the generations.

As mental ability gained prestige in human society more intelligent men were considered more ideal fathers. Man was able to expand his values and apply his imagination to a much larger degree. It is seen significant that a rapid development of the Western culture took place after the invention of clothes.

Could Out-Smart Others
Men with more brains were primarily admired by women because they could outsmart the muscle-men of any age. This did not mean, however,

that physical beauty in a man was not appreciated or displayed, even through clothes. Two examples are the showy tight trousers of the Napoleonic era and the silk-stockinged "fine leg" of the 18th century.

It is pointed out that clothing has also contributed to social evolution as a race or people divided itself into classes. For the Western culture this is more true in Europe than in the United States where different groups are not especially distinguished by their distinctive clothing.

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Saliva and Diet Protect Teeth Against Erosion

Palm Springs, Calif. (Science Service) — If you are over 40, watch out for dental erosion.

Actually there are four steps probably involved in dental erosion — the gradual wearing away of the tooth surface — Dr. Reidar F. Sognnaes of the Harvard School of Dental Medicine reported here.

Speaking to dental scientists at the annual meeting of the American Institute of Oral Biology, Dr. Sognnaes outlined the following steps:

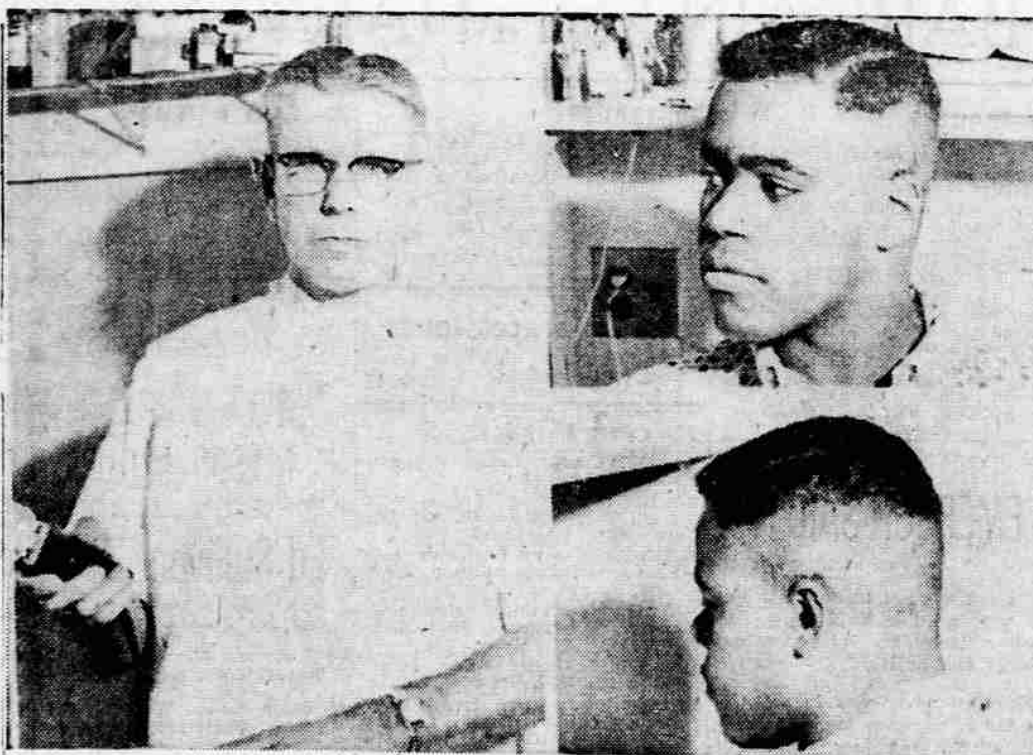
Absence of Coating
1. Malfunctioning salivary glands that mean the absence of protective salivary coating on the tooth surface.
2. Decalcifying agent present in the mouth that drains vital minerals, especially calcium, from the tooth.
3. Changes in the nature and habits of eating and drinking.

4. Mechanical friction by lip, cheek, tongue, food or toothbrush as well as biochemical and biophysical influences can destroy the superficially softened tooth substance.

This process of tooth wearing-away is most prevalent after the 40s are reached, Dr. Sognnaes explained. However, it is sometimes found in younger persons. The type of patient most prone to dental erosion seems to be the "live-wire type" or a member of the "better class," he said. The reasons for this are poorly understood, but possibly changes in saliva are responsible, he reported.

Method Described
Although it is difficult to detect in its early stages, Dr. Sognnaes described a refined method of microradiography which makes possible accurate x-rays of thin sections of teeth.

Applications of fluoride, which reduces the solubility of the tooth surface, and night-time use of shields over the affected teeth in cases of severe erosion, were among the preventive or control measures recommended in addition to sound eating and drinking habits and proper oral care.
