**Attempts at Suicide**  
 Everyone should know that any person who is badly depressed is likely to be thinking of suicide, and perhaps wishing that he had the courage or the opportunity or the means with which to do away with himself. Often the person is convinced that his family would be much better off if only he were out of the way. Many of these people are overwhelmed with feelings of sinfulness, or feelings of having been cut off entirely from God and His grace. Some of them commit suicide when voices tell them to. For instance, a man who was depressed over having lost nearly all of his fortune in the stock market, was sitting one day on a beach, when a voice, apparently at his ear, said, "Go out there and drown yourself; you are a total failure, and the world would be a much better place without you." And so he waded right out into the water and soon had to be fished out by a life guard.

There have been a number of studies made of suicides and of the notes these people left by the people who did commit suicide, and by those who only half-heartedly attempted it. The conclusion was that there was a difference. One could see that the person who was sure he was going to leave this world disposed of some personal matters in an irrevocable way. A while ago, in San Francisco, Drs. Motto and Green made a study of 175 successive cases of suicide, and 197 admissions to hospitals for attempts at suicide. In the majority of these cases the person had been under medical and perhaps psychiatric care for a month or more preceding the attempt. This story is always very significant when, as often happens, there is a question whether a person's death was due to an accident. It he was depressed and under psychiatric treatment, and if perhaps an uncle and a grandfather had committed suicide, the chances are it was not an accident.

**Third Choose Poisoning**  
 In one-third of the San Francisco cases the method chosen was poisoning with a barbiturate sleep-maker. In another study made in Los Angeles, Drs. Schneiderman and Farberow showed that in 75 per cent of these cases, the person had previously threatened suicide or had attempted it. So many people today say, "If a person threatens suicide, he or she won't do it." But this obviously is not true.

Often the depressed patient is most in danger of committing suicide about the time he has come from the hospital much improved. Then he has strength and energy enough to go seriously at the job of suicide which he has been thinking about for a long time.

One big reason why many a psychotic patient should be urged to go into a mental hospital is that there he will have some protection against this tendency to self-destruction. Unfortunately, even in mental hospitals many a patient manages to take his own life.

In the Journal of the American Medical Association there was a fine article by a number of physicians on psychiatric emergencies in general practice. As one of the doctors pointed out, often if the patient has a family physician whom he trusts and likes, this man can easily talk him into going voluntarily to

**Fleming Slates Cranberry Report**  
 Chicago—(UPI)—Arthur S. Fleming, secretary of health, education and welfare, expects to have a report late next week on possible contamination of cranberry crops in six states.

Fleming told a news conference Wednesday night his inspectors should complete their reports on crops in Washington, Oregon, Michigan, Massachusetts, Wisconsin and New Jersey by Nov. 21.

This would allow housewives five days to buy cranberries in time for the Thanksgiving holiday Nov. 26.

Fleming also defended his statement Monday in which he warned that a portion of the cranberry crop in Washington and Oregon had been contaminated by a weed-killer that caused cancer in rats.
