Cancer of the Prostate Gland
Some elderly men ask what can be done for a cancer of the prostate gland. Many urologists today first remove much of gland through the urethra (tube in the penis) and then implant in the rest of the gland some radio-active gold.

This goes far to destroy the cancer cells. In one five-year "follow-up" of 135 patients so treated, Drs. R. H. Flocks, D. A. Culp and H. B. Elkins found that 42 per cent were still living. In a similar group treated with large doses of female hormone, only 30 per cent were still alive. The female hormone often helps in relieving pain. Some urologists castrate the man with the hope that in the absence of male hormone, the cancer cells will lose much of their impulse to grow.

Enlargement of the Prostate
Scores of men write warning me to send them a medicine which will shrink the prostate gland. I have never heard of such a drug. There is only one treatment for a prostate gland which is so large that it is blocking the outlet of the bladder, and this is an operation. As I always say, the one that I think most highly of, and the only one that I would allow anyone to perform on myself, (for simple enlargement) is the transurethral one, in which the work is done through an electrically-lighted tube passed through the penis. With this operation I would probably be up and around the next day.

Vitiligo
People by the score write begging for help with vitiligo, which is a harmless condition in which the pigment goes out of certain areas of the skin, and leaves a white patch. I don't know of any medicine taken by mouth which will surely have an influence on the condition. I know a few drugs which have, of late, been used, but so far as I can learn, skin specialists have had poor luck with them. Until some treatment is found which is usually effective, the best thing to do is cover the areas on the hands and face with the preparation called "Covermark."

Is Tea Better Than Coffee?
People want to know if it would be better for them to drink tea rather than coffee. Actually, chemists tell me that the caffeine in the tea is the same as the caffeine in the coffee, and hence it doesn't make much difference what we drink. We can follow the dictates of our taste.
