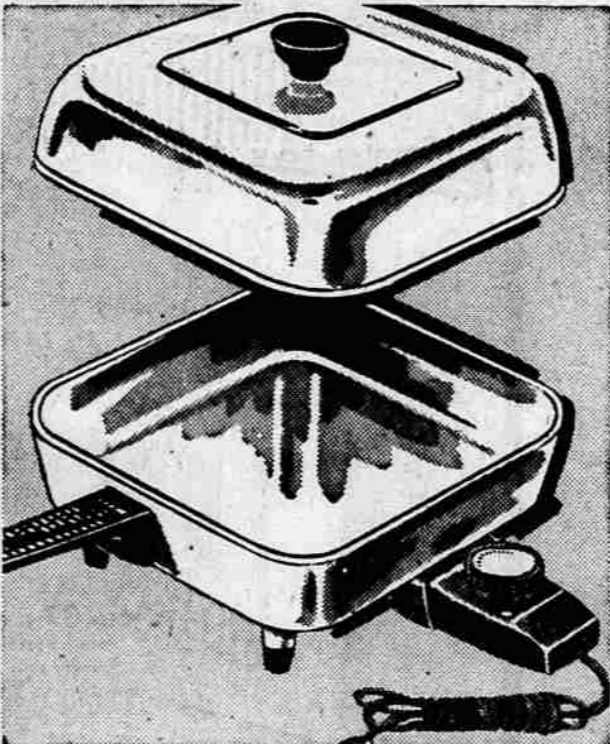

Rogue River—Magnolia Lumber corporation mill here closed last week, Drew Lamb, owner, has announced.

The mill had been operating on a basis of available logs, and when the present supply was used, the mill went on a standby basis. The mill has had trouble in recent years buying logs at a price which would provide a profit margin, Lamb said.

Superintendent of the mill is Howard Norwood, who last year was named Rogue River's "man of the year."

The mill employed 53 men.
