Intravenous Injection of Procaine To Help Aging Tissues

Because requests have come in for information as to the intravenous injection of procaine, supposedly to rejuvenate people and make them feel wonderful, I will say here that my good friend, Dr. Chauncey D. Leake, one of America's greatest experts on drug actions, has just sent me an abstract on the recent literature on this subject, and I am not well impressed with what I read.

The recent excitement was stirred up by Dr. Anna Aslan, of Roumania, and later by the much-publicized journey of an aged Archbishop to see if Dr. Aslan could make him young again.

I cannot get impressed by this use of procaine because I remember that some 20 or 30 years ago, many men were injecting it into the veins of people in an attempt to cure several diseases. The fact that, after a while, I heard no more of this use of the drug shows that it could not have been of much value. Now, Dr. Aslan claims that older people, when given this treatment, feel better and stronger. The drug is supposed, also, to help some people with arthritis. Much against Dr. Aslan's idea is the fact pointed out by Dr. Leake, that procaine is promptly split in the body, and the resultant chemicals, which are not such as can be expected to do any good, are quickly excreted from the body. Actually, studies recently made in this country do not confirm Dr. Aslan's claims.

Couple Enters Fallout Shelter

Downey, Calif.—(UPI)—Brent Parker, 19, and his 17-year-old high school bride honeymooned today in an 8-foot by 8-foot atomic fallout shelter 12 feet underground.

The young couple descended into the one-room shelter Saturday shortly after being married. They plan to stay there two weeks as "Guinea pigs" in a civil defense test.

"At least we'll have privacy," Parker said as he lifted his bride Penae in his arms and carried her into the small underground shelter.

If they remain underground for the full 14 days they will collect \$1,000 at the rate of \$50 for each of the first 13 days and \$350 for the 14th day. A finance company, owner of the shelter, will pay the money as part of a publicity stunt.

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Mother, Children Perish at Salem

Salem—(UPI)—Authorities said today the tragic deaths of a 34-year-old Salem woman and her three children was apparently the result of suicide on the part of the mother which backfired and accidentally asphyxiated the children.

The body of Mrs. Frank Margaret Nicholls was found by worried friends Thursday afternoon in a station wagon in the garage of her home in Fairmount Hills area. A hose led from the exhaust into the window of the car.

In two upstairs bedrooms were the bodies of the children, Gregory Allen, 12, Julie Ann, 10, and Melissa Jane, 9. All had been killed by carbon monoxide fumes from the station wagon.
