

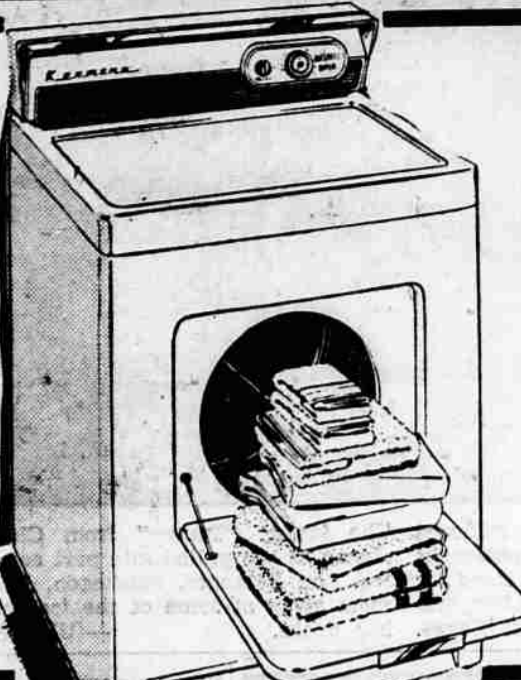

## Hirohito's Imperial Palace Described as Useless Mammoth

Tokyo (UPI) — "A harmful, useless mammoth," Hisaakira Kano called Emperor Hirohito's Imperial palace.

"Move it out of Tokyo," he urged. "Make the present park into a public park. Cut roads through it to relieve the traffic congestion in central Tokyo."

Kano's words make good sense. But where the emperor is concerned, the Japanese people react more often with emotion than logic. They were outraged.

Twenty years ago, Kano might literally have lost his head for such heresy. But times have changed. No one has suggested yet that the round-faced, little 73-year-old industrialist be executed.

Nevertheless, there were glowering looks cast his way and mutterings of "lese majeste" after he made his proposals in an article contributed to the highly respected magazine Bungei Shunju this year.

It may or may not be significant that in July, shortly after the article appeared, Kano quit his post as president of the government housing corporation.

Not that there aren't many Japanese who privately agree there is merit in Kano's ideas. But they don't care to proclaim publicly their support for his views.

The imperial palace covers 278.2 acres in the center of Tokyo. Dokan Ota, a feudal warrior and strategist, selected the hill in Edo where the palace now stands as the site of a castle for his lord, Sadamasa Uesugi. He built the first castle there in 1437 and thereby became the founder of Tokyo.

In 1868, after the supporters of the emperor overthrew the Tokugawa Shoguns (military rulers), Emperor Meiji came to Edo from the ancient capital of Kyoto, moved into the castle and renamed the city Tokyo (eastern capital). The emperors have been there ever since, their right to remain unquestioned.

Today, the palace is, as it was in the Tokugawa era, the center of the capital. With its wide open spaces, its quiet pine-shaded moats and gabled watch towers, it is an oasis of beauty and a reminder of Japan's traditional values amid the confusion and noise of a hustling, often bawdy, westernized metropolis.

**Bottleneck in Growth**

But its inviolate space, located in the center of Tokyo, is also a bottleneck in the growth of the world's largest city. To the east of the palace, squeezed between the moat and Tokyo bay, is the main center of Tokyo — the Ginza shopping district with its big department stores, the theaters of Hibiyas and Yurakuchō, the big office buildings of Marunouchi, the banks of Nihonbashi, the stock brokerage houses of Kabutocho and the wholesale districts of Asakusa.

The palace separates them from the secondary centers of Shibuya, Shinjuku, Ikebukuro and Gotanda and the fast-growing suburban residential districts which lie beyond them. Every morning, masses of humanity flow around the central area from suburban homes over railways and roads that must detour around the palace. Every night, they flow out over the same congested routes. The traffic jam at rush hours is a constant headache to Tokyo authorities. This was what sparked Kano's proposal.

## Union Report Forms Available At Portland

Portland—The U. S. Labor Department has announced here that forms for the organization report required of all unions by the new Labor Management Reporting and Disclosure Act were now available at the agency's local offices at room 317 Old U.S. Court House, 520 S. W. Morrison st., Portland.

Every labor organization must file such a report with the Commissioner, Bureau of Labor-Management Reports, U. S. Department of Labor, Washington, D.C., to be post-marked not later than midnight, Dec. 14, 1959.

**Information Required**

The reports must include copies of the union constitution and by-laws, plus information on initiation and other fees charged members. Also required is information on procedures in establishing qualifications for membership, assessments, benefit plans, methods of dealing with financial questions, selection of officers, authorizations for approval of collective bargaining demands, and other operations of labor organizations.

The Labor Department said the report forms are available in a packet consisting of six copies, along with instructions. The original and one completed copy of the report, together with attachments, must be sent to the Commissioner, Bureau of Labor-Management Reports, U.S. Department of Labor, Washington, D.C. Deadline for submission of the reports is Dec. 14.
