The Medical Roundup

WHAT IS A BIOPSY?
The word biopsy comes from two Greek roots, meaning life and to see. A biopsy is different from a necropsy. With a biopsy, what happens is that a lump appears somewhere, and in order to find out exactly what it is, the doctor cuts down, takes out a part or all of the nodule, and has a pathologist study it with his microscope. Perhaps, within a few minutes, the able expert will say, "This is inflammatory, or it is Hodgkin's disease, or it is a carcinoma (cancer)."

The expert may even go on to tell the doctor that the lump is a daughter-growth from a main cancer, perhaps in the lung or stomach, or the ovary. Often, it is important to have a biopsy made because, then, the diagnosis can usually be made with certainty.

DISAPPROVES OF CARE
Many a grandmother wishes me, wishing I could get her daughter-in-law to change her ways and give the children more affection, or better care, or secure for them better medical attention.

My feeling is that Grandma had better keep quiet. I know this is not easy to do, but since she is not likely to change her daughter-in-law's ways, and she is almost certain to get herself into a lot of unpleasantness, she had better say nothing. I would be glad to help, but it probably would do no one any good if I were to get into the fight!

Twenty-seven cases of communicable disease were reported to the Jackson county health department this week. Nine cases of influenza were reported, three each in Shady Cove, Jacksonville, and Medford. Ashland had five cases of chicken pox and three of scarlet fever. Medford reported one case of scarlet fever.

Medford also reported one case of whooping cough; two of red measles and two of infectious hepatitis. Ashland had three cases of German measles and Central Point had one case of infectious hepatitis.
