Social Security Has Benefits for Farmer

Farm - City Week 1959, which is being observed nationwide this week, provides a chance to stress the part old-age survivors, and disability insurance, playing on the farm as well as in the city. Edward Jacobson, district manager of the Medford social security office, said Saturday. Jacobson pointed out that farmers, as well as city workers, can become disabled and their families deprived of support. "Social Security is designed to help solve this problem," he said, "and farm families as well as city families now have protection when the family breadwinner becomes disabled."

Disabled farmers 50 to 65 years of age, and their dependents, can be paid monthly benefits beginning with checks for the month of April, 1960, and disabled farmers under age 50 may have their social security records frozen to protect their own and their families' rights to future benefits.

Worked Five Years To qualify under these provisions, a person must have worked under social security for at least five years within the 10 years before he became disabled, Jacobson said. The farmer whose earnings have been covered by social security only since 1955 was first able to meet this requirement on Oct. 1, 1959. In addition to this five-year requirement, the farmer, like the city worker, must have a disability so severe that he cannot do any substantial work. His disability must have lasted for six months or more and can be expected to continue indefinitely. It must also be a disability that can be de-
