The Medical Roundup

"AGAINST THE LAW"

I was happy the other day to receive from Julius Messer, in New York, one of the first copies of Peter Wildeblood's thought-provoking book on homosexuality—first published in London. This book, written by a fine man and able newspaper correspondent, shows us how viciously, unfairly and illegally the police of a great country could behave toward a man whose only offense was that he had written affectionate letters to his old war buddy, and had received similar letters from him.

One day he was grabbed by the police and thrown into jail, in spite of the fact that he had not committed any criminal act. When the British people learned about this outrage, they were disgusted. The Wolfenden Committee was appointed to study homosexual problems as well as problems of prostitution. The Committee advised the repeal of England's archaic and cruel laws in regard to homosexuality, but when polls indicated that the public was still not sufficiently educated in regard to this problem to be sympathetic, the Government did nothing. Our ancient laws on prostitution also sadly need change. Too often they are used only as a means of blackmailing unfortunate women.

I hope that all thoughtful and compassionate persons in the United States will read "Against the Law" and will then look favorably on having our laws changed. Let us all face the fact that homosexuality is a common peculiarity of both men and women. From ancient times the problem has been with us. There are all degrees of it. Some of these people can marry and stay married for years, while others cannot stand living for three days in the same apartment with a person of the opposite sex.

After studying the problem among many patients, and after reading most of the available literature on the subject, I am satisfied that most of these people cannot be cured by either psychiatry or the use of drugs. Most of them just have to learn to live with their sorrow and their unhappiness.

Smoking Parents and Children

A recent study of high school youngsters in Portland, Ore., undertaken by more than one-eight of the 10,920 girls are smokers. One-fourth of the boys and one-half of the girls had never even experimented with smoking. The percentage of smokers was highest in families in which both the father and mother smoked. Under such conditions, 31.9 per cent of the boys and 18.9 per cent of the girls were regular smokers. When neither parents smoked, the corresponding percentages were 16.2 and 6.8. Decidedly fewer smokers were found among children of the best-educated parents.

These studies are part of a research project designed to reveal the factors that cause some persons to be heavy smokers.
