IMPROVEMENT ORDINANCE
ORDINANCE NO. 3372
AN ORDINANCE declaring the assessment of property benefited for the cost of constructing: paving, curbs, gutters and driveway aprons on Saling Street from Saling Avenue to E. Jackson Street in the City of Medford, Oregon; and directing the Recorder to enter a statement thereof in the docket of City Liens and publish a notice thereof as required by the Charter.
THE CITY OF MEDFORD DOETH ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:
Section 1. WHEREAS, the City of Medford, Oregon, is authorized by the Charter to construct, pave, curb, gutters and driveway aprons on Saling Street from Saling Avenue to E. Jackson Street, in the City of Medford, Oregon; and to assess the cost thereof upon each lot or part thereof adjacent to and benefited by such improvement; and
Section 2. WHEREAS, the proportionate share of the cost of said improvement, and did fix the time and place for hearing protests against the construction of said improvement, and the assessment of the cost thereof, as aforesaid; and
Section 3. WHEREAS, a meeting of the Council was held at the time and place fixed in said Ordinance for the purpose of considering any such protests, but no protests were at such time, or at any time, made or received by the Council to the construction of said improvement, or the assessing of the cost thereof, as aforesaid, and said Council has considered the matter and deeming that said construction of said improvement was and is of material benefit to said City, and that the property to be assessed therefor will be benefited thereby to the extent of the probable amount of the respective assessments to be levied against said property, did order the construction of said improvement, and the assessment of the cost thereof, as aforesaid; and
Section 4. WHEREAS, the cost of said improvement has been and hereby is determined to be the sum of \$7,725.10.
