

Disc Jockey To Face Showdown On 'Payola'

New York (UPI)—The man who popularized rock 'n' roll was to face a showdown with his TV employer today over whether money rather than art influenced his taste in music.

Disc jockey Alan Freed, already fired from his radio job for refusing to sign a statement about "payola" was summoned to meet with WNEW-TV officials on business practices of the Big Beat show.

Jack Lynn, program manager, and Bennet Korn, general manager, said their station is particularly interested in finding out how records are chosen for the show, how performers are paid, and who winds up with the money.

The Big Beat is a program slanted towards teen-agers which features performers who mime the words to records played in the background. It is a packaged product entirely operated by Freed.

Refused To Sign
Freed was fired from his WABC radio record show Saturday because he refused to sign a statement saying he did not take "payola," the word used to describe bribes paid to disc jockeys by companies which want their releases pushed.

Freed said he never took payola but would not sign the statement because he considered it an "insult" to his "reputation for integrity."

Freed has been a teen-age idol for a number of years. He was believed to be the first disc jockey to have used the term "rock 'n' roll." Officials of several cities banned his personal appearance rock 'n' roll shows after Boston authorities blamed one such show for starting a teen-age riot there.

Freed's troubles with his employers was but one aspect of the rapidly developing payola scandals. In Detroit Sunday another fired disc jockey held a press conference.

Just 'Good Business'
Tom Clay, discharged Saturday by radio station WJLB, admitted he took bribes to plug records and defended the practice. He said his payola earnings nearly equaled his \$8,000-a-year salary, and said it was just "good business."

However, Federal Communications Commissioner Robert E. Lee, speaking in New York Sunday, said the practice was clearly a case of breaking the law. He said any station on which payola is allowed can lose its license.

Billboard magazine, a leading spokesman for the music-record industry, carried an editorial in this morning's edition which said payola was just one of many questionable practices which should be banned in the industry.

Billboard attacked the practice of promoting discs by giving free copies to dealers who sell them at a reduced price and thus push their popularity. Billboard also charged that many companies are buying their way onto record popularity charts.

Ex-Iran Queen Gets Lifelong Income

Tehran, Iran (UPI)—Shah Mohammed Reza Pahlavi has written a letter to former Queen Soraya wishing her happiness and granting her \$1,000 a week living expenses for life, palace sources disclosed today.

"Whatever steps I took were for the good of my people and for the continuance of the democratic constitutional monarchy," he wrote to the empress he divorced in 1958 because she failed to bear him an heir to the throne.

"I wish you luck," the Shah wrote. "You will always have a place in the thoughts of the people of this country and myself."

Government sources said the former queen now was free to marry but that she could never return to Iran.

Fire Destroys Landmark In Europe Saturday

Ronneby, Sweden (UPI)—Fire Saturday destroyed the SPA hotel, largest wooden building in Europe.

The 70-year old landmark with its towers and pinnacles was unoccupied. Police said the fire may have been started by an arsonist. Damage was estimated at \$400,000.
