Continued Wintry Weather Forecast for Nation In Next 30 Days, Bureau Says

Suitland, Md. — (Science Service) — Continued wintry conditions for much of the nation during the coming 30 days has been predicted by the Weather Bureau's extended forecast section.

Only brief periods of relative warmth will break the cold spell gripping the country's mid-section from the Rocky to the Appalachian Mountains. The outlook for the period mid-November to mid-December calls for temperatures to average below seasonal normals over this area as well as in the Pacific Northwest.

Coldest weather is predicted for the Central and Northern Plains, which have already borne the force of two raging blizzards since Nov. 9.

Above normal temperatures are forecast for the far Southwest and also along the Atlantic coastal strip. In unspecified areas, near normal temperatures are expected.

Precipitation, much of it in the form of snow because of the cold temperatures, is forecast to exceed normal over the eastern third of the nation and the far Southwest, including the central and southern West Coast, as well as the Northern Plains.

All other areas of the country are expected to record near normal amounts, except for subnormal over the Pacific Northwest.

Reason for the unseasonably cold waves pouring down into the nation's middle is seen in the world-wide weather pattern, Jerome Namias, head of the bureau's extended forecast section, told Science Service.

He said the present pattern, with strong north-south winds instead of the usual westerlies, allowed the cold Arctic air to sweep much farther south than normal. It also brings warm, moist air from the Gulf up the East Coast. Where these two conflicting air masses meet, the stage is set for violent weather.

The world-wide pattern is governed by a series of four extensive ridges and troughs in the globe-circling river of air—known as the planetary
