The Medical Roundup

Common Problems in Epilepsy
I recently received a thought-provoking letter from a nice woman who says she is an epileptic.

When she takes Dilantin, she has no seizures. She agrees with me that epilepsy often must be hereditary. One of her grandmothers had the disease. Evidently my correspondent mis-read my column because she says, "We are not all insane." Certainly, I never said all epileptics are insane; what I probably said was that in a high percentage of the families of epileptics are mentally disturbed or mentally retarded, or handicapped by a violent temper. I probably also quoted experts who say so truly that many an epileptic child in school is in difficulties, not because of fits — they are not his problem; his problem is to adjust to life at home and at school, to control his violent temper, and not to fight with people.

Not Worried
My correspondent says what so many epileptics say, that she is not worried about her fits; she is worried about her grown daughter who, years ago, when in school, was found to be a bit retarded mentally. Later, the girl went into "a nervous breakdown" and spent several years in a mental hospital. This type of trouble which I meet with so commonly in the families of my epileptic patients, is seldom mentioned by the experts on this disease. They say the trouble is not hereditary. Evidently, they don't ask about these mentally disturbed or mentally retarded members of a family; so long as a relative does not have a fit, he is listed as "normal." As I have to keep saying here, very few of the epileptics I see in my office complain of fits. Many complain of nervous troubles; of their inability to get along easily with other people, and of the great efforts they have to make to keep from "blowing their top."

My correspondent tells me that her doctors hold at her idea (which probably is correct) that her epilepsy was inherited from her grandmother, and has since been passed on to the daughter. They hoot at the idea that the daughter has inherited anything, or is an epileptic. They point to the fact that her electroencephalograms are normal. Apparently, they forget that the daughter's focus of epilepsy can be down near the base of her brain where it does not affect the recording machine which is fastened by little wires to the top of her head.

Now, the poor mother says that the daughter, who is back home again, is nearly driving everyone wild with her temper tantrums.

As my correspondent says, "You are so right. My poor sister's problem is not fits; it is trying to live with people without snapping their heads off. She, who would so love to be a nice person, with plenty of beaus, every so often gets so violent in her temper tantrums that we have to put her in a mental hospital. There she is not crazy; she is just so 'difficult' she cannot live in a home. I love her, and I used to try to have her live with me, but it just wasn't possible."

A nice woman with an epileptic husband writes, "How true what you say. My husband is a good man and an able man, and only rarely has he ever had a fit, but he is a man you can never contradict, or you will have a dangerous and nasty fight on your hands."

On a few occasions, when very tired, he has gotten so violent he has had to spend a few days in a mental hospital. We have a daughter who has never had a fit since her childhood when she had "fever convulsions," but if she takes three drinks, she goes berserk, and smashes furniture. When in college, on two occasions she got so violent the police had to lock her up overnight!

I need hardly say that many epileptics are sweet persons. In school, an epileptic child of mine was so good-natured his nickname was "Happy."
