

Senator From Hawaii Shining Example For Asians on American Way of Life

Washington—UPI—The taxpayers got a worthwhile employee in U.S. Sen. Hiram L. Fong.

Fong is a Republican from the 50th state, Hawaii. His worth to the taxpayers has not much to do, however, with his party affiliation.

What makes Fong as especially valuable package is that he is living, breathing propaganda in support of the free way of life. Fong is a U.S. citizen, but an Asiatic, Chinese by blood line.

For some weeks now, Fong and a small party have been touring Asia on the free side of the bamboo curtain. Communist propaganda delights, especially, in picturing the United States as a nation of enslaved workers and scorned minorities. Only in the Communist paradise, as the Kremlin tells it, can the common man aspire to a better life for himself and his family. This kind of baloney sells well in those underprivileged nations where envy of the good things of life so easily creates hatred of those who enjoy them. Asia is an area of under-privileged nations, like Africa and Central and South America.

Has Qualifications
No American statesman is more fitted than Fong to counter Communist propaganda about opportunity in

the United States. The word from members of his party is that Fong has been doing a great job at that. His own

life story would do as a start-er: Son of a poor Chinese family in Hawaii, a bootblack as a boy. There was education

to be had, however, and Fong got it. He was successful and wealthy long before his election this year to the Senate.

Fong's success and wealth were attained under the ground rules which Communist propaganda scorns, ridicules and mistakes. Scorn,

cannot stand up, however, to what Fong achieved. He is a show case package in the

Space Research Center To Probe Air on Jupiter

Ithaca, N.Y. (Science Service)—The world's largest radar antenna soon to be built in Puerto Rico will be used to probe the surface of the planet Jupiter.

If radar signals are reflected by Jupiter, U. S. scientists expect to gather new information about the planet's surface. If no signals are reflected, scientists will know for the first time that the largest of the outer planets is shrouded in a deep atmosphere that absorbs radio waves.

Big Receiving Dish
The giant radar, to be the biggest in the world, is being financed by the Department of Defense and will be used by Cornell University's new Center for Radiophysics and Space Research.

The radar is to have a 1,000-foot receiving dish nestled in a natural bowl of coral limestone. This antenna is four times larger than Britain's powerful Jodrell Bank unit which now holds the record for contacting Venus.

20-Degree Sweep
The Cornell-designed radar unit is to be able to probe at distances of 400,000,000 miles. It will operate on a peak power of 2,500,000 watts and a frequency near 420 megacycles a second. The finger-like radar beam will be able to sweep 20 degrees in each direction, and may shed new knowledge on the earth's own ionosphere. In addition, the radar will be able to bounce signals from the moon, Venus, Mars, Mercury and the sun.

The new Center for Radiophysics and Space Research will be directed by Thomas Gold, 39-year-old professor of astronomy, physics and electrical engineering. Other installations planned for the Center will include a radio astronomy receiving station south of Ithaca and a transmitting station on Cornell's campus.
