Diet and Cholesterol

Today thousands of men and women are dieting in an effort to reduce the amount of cholesterol in their blood. They hope that by reducing the level of blood cholesterol they can lessen their chances of developing hardening or ulceration of their arteries. In a recent article by Dr. Oscar W. Portman, of the Harvard School of Public Health, we learn that many authorities now agree that the amount of cholesterol in the blood can be lessened by eating less hard fat of animal origin, and more oils de-

rived from plants.

Because of this, today many persons are using less butter and cream and lard and hard forms of shortening, and more corn oil, cotton seed oil, peanut oil, soy bean oil, or safflower oil. It still is a question if this change in diet will lower the amount of cholesterol in the blood sufficiently to do any good — if it will stop the process of hardening in the arteries, or if it will clear up some of the damage that already has been done. Because these questions are still not as well answered as I wish they were, as yet I am not dictatorial with my patients. I keep waiting for more information — as many of the experts are doing.

lester in the blood, sufficiently so that the reduction could be counted on to lessen the degree of hardening of the person's arteries. Dr. Portman and others do not feel that as yet we have any medicine that will surely do what we want it to do. Substances called sitosterols have been used, but as Dr. Portman says, in view of the fact that one can produce hardening of the arteries by feeding these chemicals, it doesn't look as if they could serve as good medicine. Nicotinic acid has been widely used, but Dr. Portman says, such large doses have to be used to lower the level of cholesterol that he doubts if the treatment is safe.

Still Question

As Dr. Page — one of the world's experts in this field — once said to me, some of the substances that are given to reduce blood cholesterol will produce some lowering, but it is still a question if the amount of this will be enough to help the patient.

The search for drugs that will put a stop to hardening of the arteries or will cure hardening of the arteries, or will prevent heart attacks or strokes, is going forward
