What happens is that when she gets some distance from her house she gets a terrible panic, and feels that she just must rush back home — because only there will she find safety. She has had a lot of psychiatric treatment but it didn't do any good. She suspects that her trouble is due partly to the fact that she is much like her very worrisome aunt who is in a mental hospital.

If the lady could get from the Public Library a big book called "The Locomotive God," written by the late Professor W. E. Leonard, she would see there how extremely difficult it is to overcome a phobia of going away from home. The only persons I know who have triumphed over it had the guts to keep going out and going out until at last they forgot their fear. In a few cases I found that the woman was using the phobia to pun-
