QUACK MACHINES

In a recent number of the Journal of the American Medical Association there is an interesting article written by my friend, Mr. Oliver Field, who is the country's expert on quacks. He has a list of them, with much information on the life history of each one. I read that a former engineer is now putting out what appears to be a highly scientific machine which costs from \$250 to \$350. It is supposed to cure pretty near anything. I imagine it is patterned somewhat on the machines that a certain Albert Abrams used to sell many years ago. He sold them mainly to none-too-bright old physicians who had never been able to get a practice. He sold them, also, to men who called themselves doctors and who practiced on the fringe of medicine.

What happens now, with the new machines, is that the company that makes them places advertisements saying that sufferers from sinus troubles, or arthritis, or high blood pressure, or hardening of the arteries, should send nine cents for a booklet which will tell them much good news. When the sucker gets the booklet, he reads that a certain so-called doctor in his

community has one of the new "miracle machines" and with it is curing people right and left. The "doctor" is assured by the machine-maker that with it he soon can have a practice worth \$30,000 a year. It may interest people who are inclined to fall for this sort of "come-on" that already the Federal Food and Drug Administration people are filing actions against some of the users of these devices. These days people so love gadgets that many easily can be taken in by any con-man who offers to treat them with a fancy-looking lot of dials and flashing lamps.
