

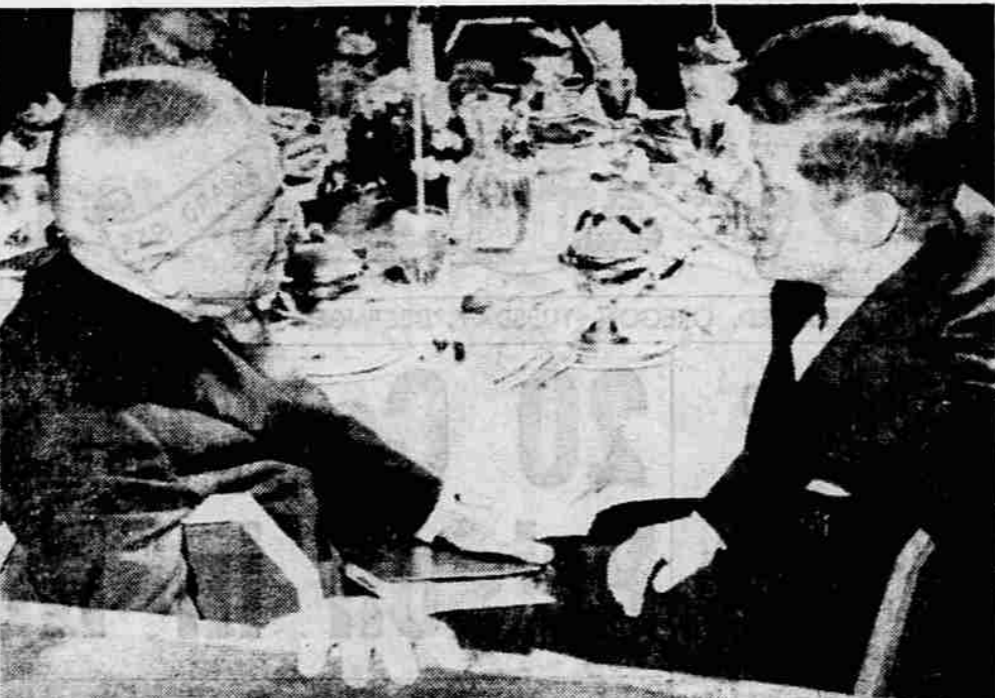
Steels, Electronics Lead Stocks Higher

New York (UPI)—Steels, electronics and scattered specials led the stock market higher today. Monday's advance, the 13th in the last 14 sessions, brought the industrials to within 12 1/2 points of their record high.

The congressional probe into drug industry pricing practices brought heavy selling into the section. Schering and Vick lost 3 or more, Merck, American Home Products and Carter around 2 or better, and Pfizer a point. Parke Davis fell 1 1/2.
