

Four Injured in Four Accidents in City This Week

Four traffic accidents were reported to city police Monday and Tuesday. Four persons were injured in two of them, police said.

Three persons were injured in a two-car accident on Highway 62 at the Bear Creek bridge Monday noon, when a car operated by Lula Mae Lock, 46, of Eagle Point, slid into the opposite lane of traffic on the bridge and collided with a pickup operated by Duane Robert Burton, 34, of Butte Falls, according to police.

Injured in the crash were Roberta Beth Burton, with injuries to the right leg, shoulder and neck, the extent of which are not known; Lula Mae Lock, injured left leg; and Robert Lee Nelson, 29, of Eagle Point, with a cut above his eye, police reported.

The injured were taken to the Sacred Heart hospital, according to police. They said both cars suffered extensive damage.

Three-Car Crash
A three-car accident at the intersection of Crater Lake ave. and Delta Waters rd., at 7:55 a.m. Tuesday, sent Linda Louise Nelson, of route 3, box 67, Medford, to Sacred Heart hospital with an injured mouth and cut cheek, according to police.

Police said a car operated by James Forrest Silva, 25, of Eagle Point, failed to slow down when the car in front of him, operated by Camden Clare Weller, 18, of Springfield, slowed for the intersection of Crater Lake highway with Delta Waters rd. The Silva car hit the rear end of Weller's vehicle and then veered into the other lane of traffic, striking a car operated by Mary Kay Lehman, 20, of 3180 South Pacific highway, Medford, according to police records.

Linda Nelson was a passenger in the Weller vehicle. Police said that all three cars suffered extensive damage.

Spreading Salt
An accident at 3:57 a.m. Tuesday involved a pickup truck, owned by the city of Medford, and a car operated by Don Ivan Evans, 33, of 931 Queen Anne ave. Evans was cited by city police for improper passing after his car collided with the pickup, which was driving in the middle of the road, spreading salt on the pavement.

The pickup was operated by Gay Maurice Anderson Jr., 617 Cedar st., Central Point. Police said the pickup had a red warning light which was functioning at the time of the accident. Police said there were no injuries.

An accident Monday at 12:39 p.m. occurred when a car operated by James Terry Bohls, 1225 Mt. Pitt ave., hit the rear of a car operated by Paul Vannoy Algeo, Jacksonville, when the latter vehicle slowed to turn into a driveway.

Police cited Bohls for following too close. There were no injuries, police said.
