

Russia Permits Family of U.S. Man To Leave

Moscow (UPI)—Soviet officials have authorized the wife and son of Cleveland resident John Armonas to leave the U.S.S.R. and join him after a 18-year separation, it was learned Thursday.

The Christmas Eve news came less than a week after Soviet approval for two Lithuanian youths to leave the country to be reunited with their American parents, Mr. and Mrs. Paulus Leonas, Chicago.

Both actions are the result of appeals made to Premier Nikita Khrushchev personally, but the Armonas appeal had additional support from Pennsylvania Gov. David L. Lawrence and a Cleveland newspaper, the Cleveland Press.

Donna Armonas, 24, approached the premier during a luncheon in Pittsburgh where he promised to make it possible for her mother, Barbara, 54, and brother, John, 19, to leave their home in Pabylis, Lithuania.

The family was split up in 1940 when Donna and her father were evacuated as American citizens.

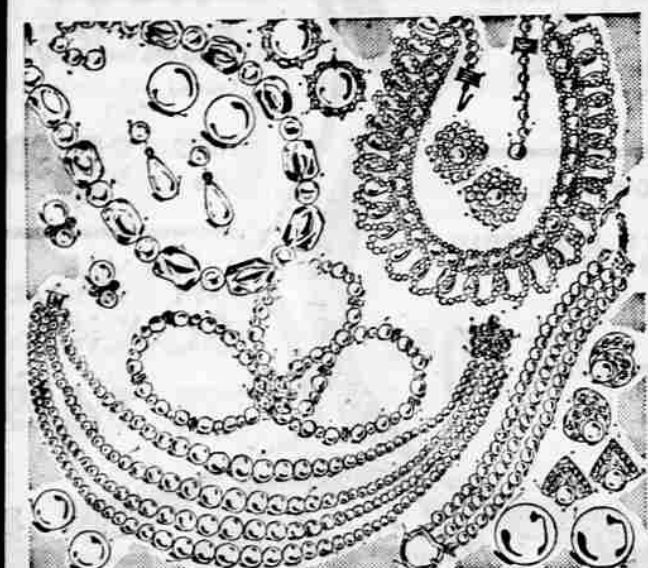
But the mother and son did not have American citizenship and have not been able to leave the country.

Armonas and his family had hoped to be reunited by Christmas, but formalities will take some weeks.

In the case of the Leonas family, the Soviets granted exit visas to the two boys, Ginas, 20, and Tomas, 17, and their case is in the hands of the U.S. Embassy here.
