Fir Millmen Predict Good Year

Portland - (UPI) - Douglas fir millmen are taking an optimistic view of business for 1960, H. V. Simpson, executive vice president of the West Coast Lumbermen's Association, said Saturday.

He predicted that demand for West Coast lumber will be high next year, despite the tight money situation. He listed a pent-up demand for housing, an increasing population, stepped-up industrial plant expansion, and the continuing construction of schools, churches and commercial structures as good market prospects for West Coast lumber.

Production for the Douglas fir region of Western Oregon and Washington this year was 8,400,000,000 board feet, compared to 8,042,982,000 in 1958.

Former Insurance Commissioner Dies

Portland - (UPI) - Former state insurance commissioner Claire A. Lee, 70, died Saturday.

He was stricken recently with pneumonia and had been in ill health for several years. He was appointed Oregon's insurance commissioner in 1927 and held the job for four years. He also was well known as an insurance auditor and counselor and had held public office in both Marion and Lane counties.
