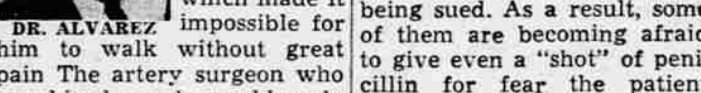

**The Tendency to Sue Doctors**

I recently read an article by William Peters on what is already happening because of many lawsuits in which an innocent doctor is stuck for some huge damages. To illustrate: Peters told of a patient with a narrow place in the artery of his leg, which made it impossible for him to walk without great pain. The artery surgeon who saw him knew he could probably make him perfectly well again by, first, injecting into the artery a drug which, with x-rays, would show just where the narrow place was. Then, he would cut this place out and put in a tube, perhaps made of some plastic. With this, the man would be able to go striding along again.



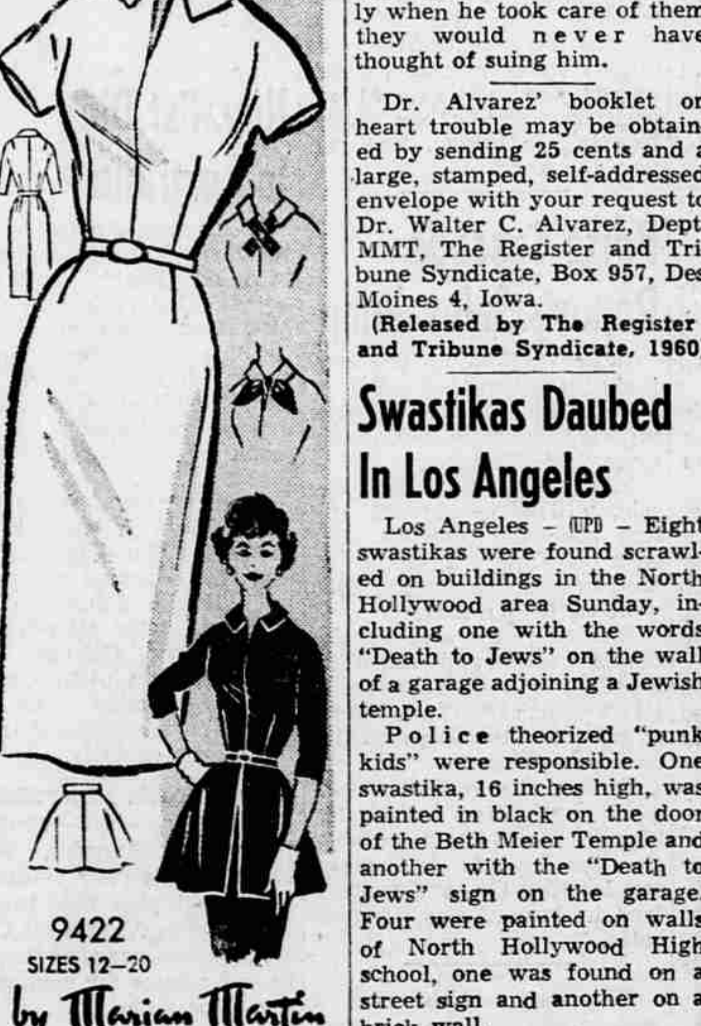

But the surgeon just dismissed the man and let him go. Why? Because, recently, he had been so shocked by the experience of a fellow artery surgeon who one day had-as he had done a few hundred times before-injected the usual dye, and the patient, who evidently had a very rare sensitivity to the substance, had gotten paralyzed from the waist down. Although no doctor, knowing the facts, would have thought of blaming the surgeon, a jury awarded the paralyzed man \$250,000. As one would expect, surgeons all over the country began to wonder if they could afford to run the risk of some day being wiped out financially by such an accident. Why take the risk? Sweetland was the keynote speaker at the Lane County Democratic convention meeting in Eugene Saturday.

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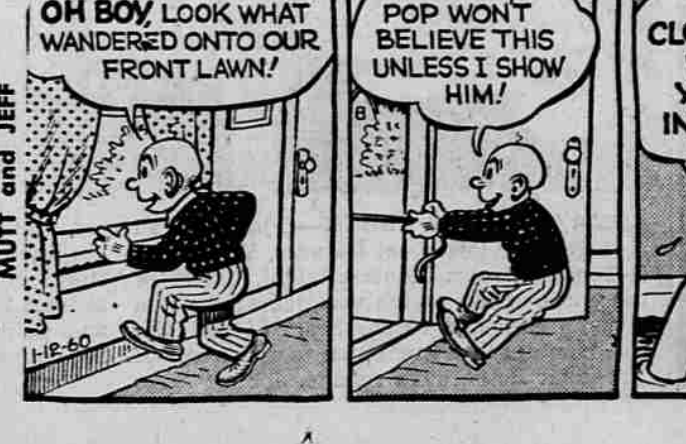
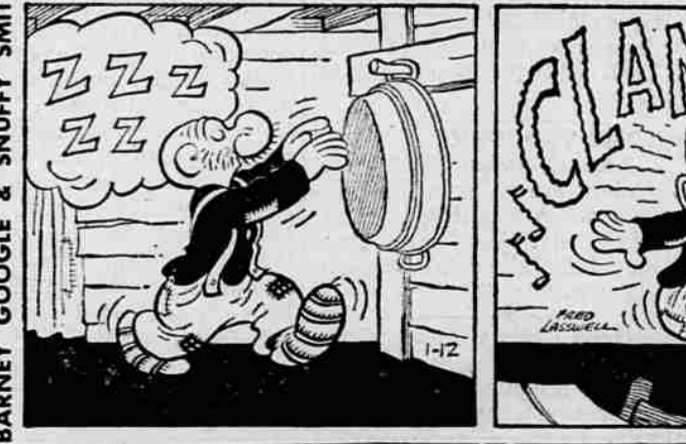
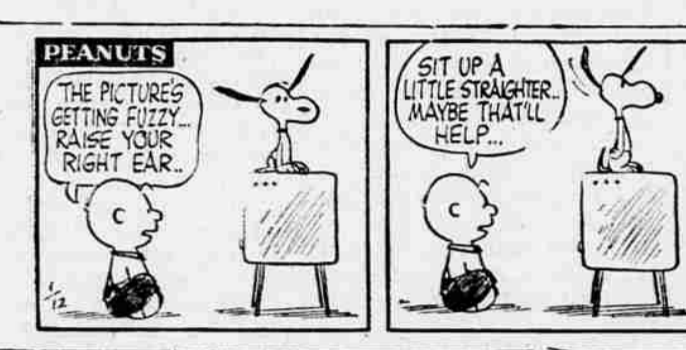
