The Medical Roundup

A GALLBLADDER DIET
Hundreds of people tell me that when an x-ray man accidentally discovered that their gallbladder was packed full of stones they were told to go on a fat-free "gallbladder diet."

In more than half of these cases, the patient tells me that she never had any pain or indigestion; in fact, she still has the digestion of an ostrich. Then what is the sense of her dieting? What reason can her doctor give for his order? So far as I know, his only reason is an unthinking habit. He prescribes a fatless diet because for the last 50 years or more all but an occasional doctor has prescribed such a diet for all types of gallbladder disease. Is there any good reason for doing this? Some able experts cannot see any. I never heard of a "gallbladder diet" being prescribed at the Mayo Clinic.

Sometimes, when at a consultation, I have asked my fellow physician why he prescribed the fatless diet. He said, "I don't know. I suppose it helps to keep more gallstones from forming." With this, I may have picked up the x-ray films of the patient and asked, "Do you think another stone could possibly be packed into that gallbladder?" And he has had to admit it could not be done. "Well, helps digestion." "But," say I, "the woman has a marvelous digestion already; how can we possibly make it any better?" Perhaps then my friend, in desperation, says, "Perhaps we give the diet because she hasn't a functioning gallbladder. It has no function because it is filled with stones." "But then," I say, "if that is your reason, why do you never prescribe a diet for a person whose gallbladder has been removed surgically?" About that time I am afraid my medical friend has only one great desire — and that is to have me go away and leave him alone!

Many people ask me, "What is the function of the gallbladder?" And the answer is that it is a little pear-shaped reservoir designed to store bile until meal-times, when the yellow fluid can be poured out into the bowel to help in the digestion of fats. The point that few people know is that nearly all men and women without a gallbladder manage to digest their fats so well that they have no discomfort. Some few species of animals never have a gallbladder.

I know that a few thousand people who have just read this are wondering — but if there is absolutely no sense to a "Gallbladder diet," why do almost all physicians do a lot of needless things just because in college we were taught to do them, and it has never since occurred to us to ask what was the original idea, and was there any sense to it? I could list a number of such amusingly useless things we do.

For instance, when a nurse gives a hypodermic injection, she always first dabs the skin with some alcohol. Why does she do this? Because she was taught to. Can alcohol, in a moment, sterilize the skin? Absolutely not, and we doctors all know that. Is there

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Proposed Road Favored by Group

Gold Beach—The Chamber of Commerce here has passed a resolution in favor of a highway up the Rogue and Illinois rivers to Selma, R. R. VanLeer, Chamber president, announced.

VanLeer pointed out that the lower Rogue and Illinois river areas contain billions of board feet over-ripe old growth timber which has not been harvested because of the lack of access roads.

He also mentioned the recreational and fishing areas along the two rivers that are almost totally unused because of the lack of roads.

The Chamber spokesman explained that the Port of Gold Beach, presently being built through the aid of more than \$4,000,000 in federal funds, cannot be utilized by shippers in the interior of southern Oregon because of the lack of road connection.

VanLeer said that along the southern Oregon coastline from Coquille to Crescent City, Calif., a distance of 143 miles, there is no east-west road.
