**Officials Prepare Public for Failure**

Washington - (UPI) - The Eisenhower administration has begun to prepare public opinion for possible failure of the spring summit conference to produce any real East-West agreement on major cold war issues.

Qualified authorities said Saturday the next few weeks can be expected to bring repeated warnings from high officials against expecting too much, if anything, from the May 16 session with Soviet Premier Nikita Khrushchev in Paris.

This campaign to forestall soaring expectations has both international and domestic political implications.

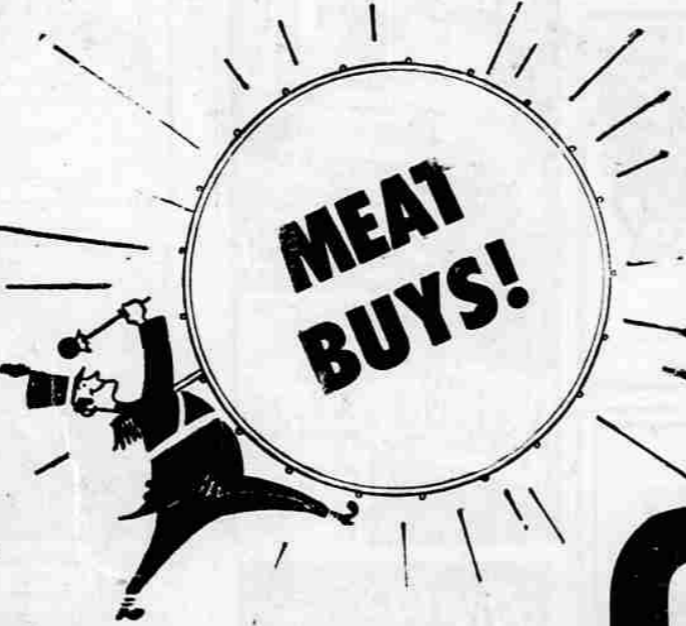

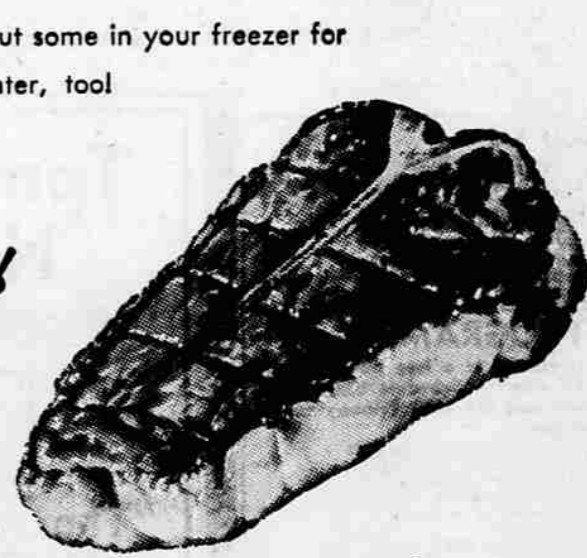
