Fruit Flip

In two shakes you can make a tangy milk'n fruit flip to snack with crisp butter cookies or a he-man sandwich. Mix sweet cherry or berry preserves with rich milk in an electric blender, mixer or with a hand beater.

Add sliced fresh dates to Waldorf salad or cole slaw dressed with sour cream. Good, too, combined with cream cheese and a touch of grated orange rind, then spooned into peach or pear halves.

Mix 1 can mushroom soup, 1 cup skim milk and 1/4 teaspoon salt in a skillet and heat over a medium flame. Add 1 1/2 cups cooked packaged precooked rice, 1 can (6 1/2) ounces of crab meat and a package of frozen peas. Stir well. Then top with 4 slices of process American cheese and bring to a boil. Turn out the gas flame, cover the skillet and let stand for 10 minutes. Serve with a crisp green salad, hard rolls and a luscious apple dessert.
