

Young Smokers Found to Believe In Cancer Link

New York. (Science Service)—Two-thirds of America's teen-agers believe there is some link between lung cancer and smoking, but 21 per cent nevertheless smoke cigarettes.

More than 4 per cent think that both light and heavy smokers run a greater risk of getting lung cancer than non-smokers.

Opinion here after conducting a poll on teen-age smoking habits. During November and December, 1959, representatives from the Institute questioned 10,763 secondary-school students. The poll covered grades seven through 12 in 200 schools in every area of the country, including Alaska and Hawaii.

their 16th birthday. On the basis of these figures, the Institute estimates that of the entire secondary school population, five per cent of all teen-age boys are smoking at the age of 12 and better than 25 per cent are smoking at 16. Nearly three per cent of girls are smoking by age 13 and more than 13 per cent at 17.
