The Medical Roundup

Inheritance of High Blood Pressure and Coronary Heart Disease

In a recent number of "Circulation," Dr. C. B. Thomas reported on a long-term study of the parents and grandparents of hundreds of Johns Hopkins' medical students. He found what was to be expected, namely, that a DR. ALVAREZ young man with high blood pressure has a greater-than-average chance of having parents and grandparents with a high blood pressure. There is some tendency, also, to inherit coronary heart disease.

Appetite

I learn that several of the drugs now much used for the reduction of appetite contain a substance called phenylpropanolamine. According to an author in the Journal of the American Medical Association, its effects are not pronounced. If one takes enough of it to take away much of the appetite, it is likely to have some undesirable side-effects. A "reducing" drug sometimes put in chewing gum is said to be benzocaine. This is supposed to anesthetize the taste buds or nerve endings in the mouth, but according to the expert, it has not been proved to everyone's satisfaction that this will lessen the appetite.

According to the expert writing in the Journal of the AMA, "there is no vitamin, or mineral, or protein food supplement that will produce a reduction in body weight." Drugs of the amphetamine or dextroamphetamine type can lessen the appetite, but they are nerve stimulants, and hence had better not be taken in the afternoon if they are not to interfere with sleep that night. I am a bit afraid of these drugs because I have known a few persons who got to taking a handful of the tablets every day.

According to the Government experts, "there is no device effective for 'spot reducing,' melting away fat, rubbing or vibrating it off, or breaking up fatty deposits." One cannot count on the vibrators to do the work. Unfortunately, a good sensible reduction diet is still the only good treatment for a fat person.

Lung Volume and Smoking
Drs. H. Blackburn, J. Brozек, and H. L. Taylor of Lancaster, Pennsylvania recently reported a study made of lung volumes and vital capacities in the cases of men averaging 52 years of age. Some were smokers and some non-smokers, some were heavy smokers, and some had stopped for at least a year.

Interesting was the finding that the vital capacity (the amount of air a man can blow out of his lungs) was smaller in all of the smokers than in the non-smokers. The man with a low vital capacity is
