

Appling Urges Help in Lack of Teachers of Deaf

Salem — (UPI) — Secretary of State Howell Appling Jr. said today he has asked for support from the Oregon congressional delegation for federal legislation to help overcome what he termed the critical shortage of teachers of the deaf.

The measure would make funds available to colleges and universities to encourage post graduate work in speech and hearing fields.

Appling wrote the delegation "I am aware that it may be charged that this is simply another step toward federal control of education, but as one bearing the responsibility for administration of the Oregon State School of the Deaf, I can testify that the problem cannot be dismissed that easily."

Appling said a limited program of teacher student training for the deaf in cooperation with Oregon College of Education is now being established. He said, however, the loss of trained personnel to other states has been "a serious discouragement to action at the state level."

Stepinac Death Report Received

Belgrade, Yugoslavia — (UPI) — The official Yugoslav news agency Tanjug said today it had received report without confirmation that Cardinal Aloysius Stepinac was dead.

The report came in a telephone call from the agency's correspondent in Krasic, the cardinal's home since his release from prison in 1951. Krasic is near Zagreb.

Reports Tuesday said the cardinal had been confined to his room since Sunday with a bad cold.

The report said he caught the cold after staying out too long in a chilly church while participating in Sunday mass.

Portland Strike In Fourth Month

Portland — (UPI) — The Portland newspaper strike began its fourth month today with no end in sight.

Ten joint negotiation sessions between the striking Stereotypers Union and management of the Oregon Journal and the Oregonian failed to produce any agreement. The last one, held under federal mediation auspices, was on Jan. 18.

The strike began Nov. 10 and Pressmen and Paper Handlers later declared themselves on strike. Members of other unions have observed picket lines although many employees who belong to the American Newspaper Guild have returned to work at the Oregonian plant where publication of joint editions continues.

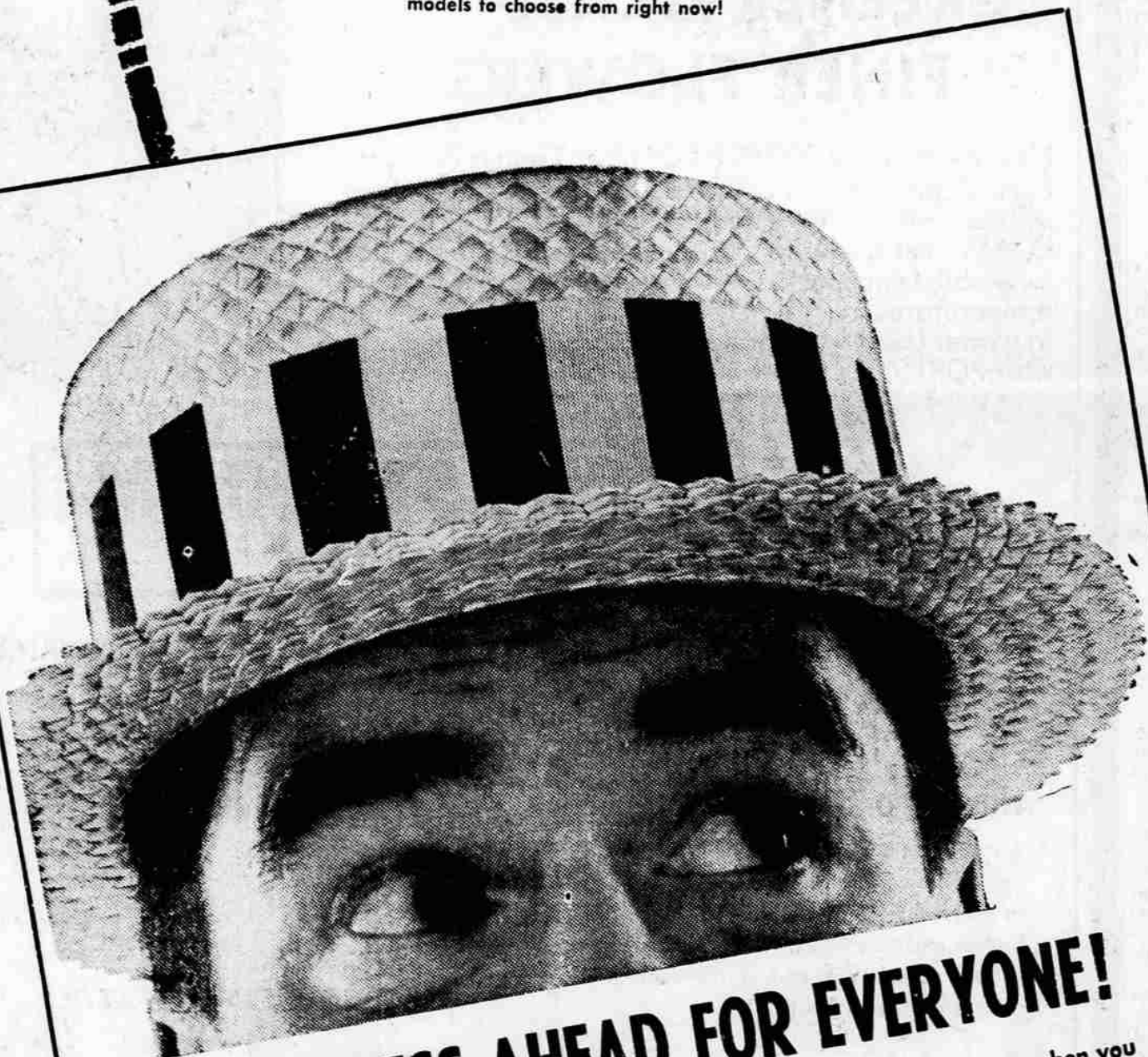
