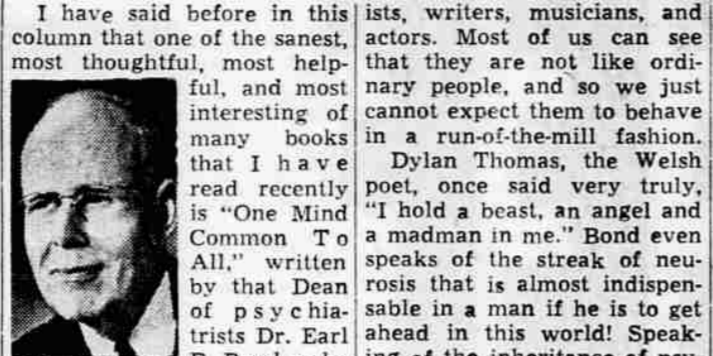

The Medical Roundup

I have said before in this column that one of the sanest, most thoughtful, most helpful, and most interesting of many books that I have read recently is "One Mind Common To All," written by that Dean of psychiatrists Dr. Earl D. Bond as he says so wisely, none of us is perfectly sane, or sane at all times. At times we all of us can do foolish things. Some of us are over-conscientious, or overly-sensitive and touchy, or overly-full of fears, antagonisms, prejudices or moods. As Shakespeare said, "the web of our life is of mingled yarn, good and ill together."

Those of us who have good sense must always keep fighting to act with wisdom and self-control. Some of us must fight not to brood over the unhappy events of the past, and not to keep fearing imaginary troubles in the future. As Dr. Bond says, often we wonder when we see a fine, talented, well-educated, or creative person, who is usually wise and sane, on occasions behaving like a spoiled child. A part of his mind works well, while a part is working poorly. Dr. Bond says that "the successful man with one strong prejudice has much to learn from a mental patient on one delusion!"

More Interesting
Dr. Bond speaks of the people on the fringe of insanity—the misers, tramps, fanatics, dictators, geniuses, and alcoholics, who are a motley crew, "but among them are those who have written the liveliest pages of human history." Most of us would prefer any day to read the life of a scamp rather than that of a saint—the scamp is so much more interesting than is even the average "normal" man.

How wise Dr. Bond is when (p. 9) he says "I have little confidence in my theories, and much confidence in my facts." I say, God grant that some day, many more psychiatrists like Dr. Bond will come to feel this way about the theories on which they have built the structure of their now crumbling edifice.

Dr. Bond goes on to speak of the terrible expense that is laid on our tax-payers by the millions of neurotic, unhappy, ineffective and upset persons. They cause countless frayed temper, miserable marriages, "Surely no nation can be considered so sound and strong of one-third of its people are sick in heart and mind."

New Start Needed
How remarkable is Dr. Bond's description of an interesting woman patient of his who said, "I am bored by religion; I am bored by my music; I am bored by my stomach symptoms, my books, by everything. I don't like my house; I don't like the city I live in; I am bored by my husband!" She certainly needed to get a new and better start in life. Perhaps she could have been cured if she had only gone into some service in which she could have helped many people.

As Bond says, "Saints and others who take religion much to heart are not to be well-rounded people; nor are artists, creative thinkers, or inventors. One part of them is so advanced that other parts have not caught up." We have to forgive them their faults because of their great gifts. Actually, the world is rather charitable to the unconventionalities of great artists, writers, musicians, and actors. Most of us can see that they are not like ordinary people, and so we just cannot expect them to behave in a run-of-the-mill fashion.
