

### Auto Industry Prepares To Cut Back Production

Detroit - (UPI) - The auto industry is preparing to cut back its production because of slipping sales, according to industry sources.

Both Imperial Division of Chrysler Corp. and Buick Division of General Motors Corp. revealed Tuesday that they planned to lower production within a month.

Ward's Automotive Reports, statistical agency for the industry, said today sales were progressing at a rate which would result in the sale of 5,743,000 units in a year. Immediately after the steel strike, officials of all the major companies predicted sales this year would total about 6,500,000 or about 750,000 more than is now indicated.

**To Close For Week**  
A spokesman for Imperial said that division planned to close for a week beginning next Monday and then would resume production with a reduced work force. The spokesman said 400 employees would be laid off when work resumed with production rates "adjusted to balance field stocks."

The spokesman said the adjustments were necessary because production schedules have been "above normal" since the end of the steel strike late in January.

A spokesman for Buick said the division planned "some short work weeks" next month but no layoffs were planned at this time.

### Glaciers Said To Be Declining

Washington - (Science Service) - Glaciers, which cover about ten per cent of the world's land area, are definitely declining, a Russian scientific report contends.

In an article originally published in Russia and translated and distributed here by the U.S. Department of Commerce, Prof. G. Avsyuk, chairman of the working group on glaciology of the International Geophysical Year, said it can be stated "confidently" that glaciology is diminishing.

Up to the time of the IGY, he said, glacier data were only approximate and inaccurate. It was thought, for example, that the thickness of Antarctica's ice cover was about 2,000 to 2,600 feet. However, glaciological investigations during the IGY, most of which were carried out by the United States and Russia, indicated that the average thickness of the ice was close to 6,500 feet and sometimes reached 13,000 feet. Glaciation, which constantly increases and decreases, exerts a considerable influence on the earth's climate, Prof. Avsyuk reported. Glaciers cover almost 6,000,000 square miles of the earth and contain 11 times as much water as all the land's surface waters.

### Traveler Likes Better Highways

Temple, Tex. - (UPI) - Edward Lee, 63, breezed into Temple recently for the first time in three years and observed that he found "much better highways" on this trip.

Lee is something of a highway expert although his business is sharpening knives and scissors. He does all of his traveling on a bicycle and averages about 10,000 miles a year.

The wiry, gray-haired native of Hot Springs, Ark., said he started cycling around the U.S. many years ago.

"I like to see the country," he said.

"I just stay around long enough to get a couple of dollars for food and then move on," he added as he pedaled away.

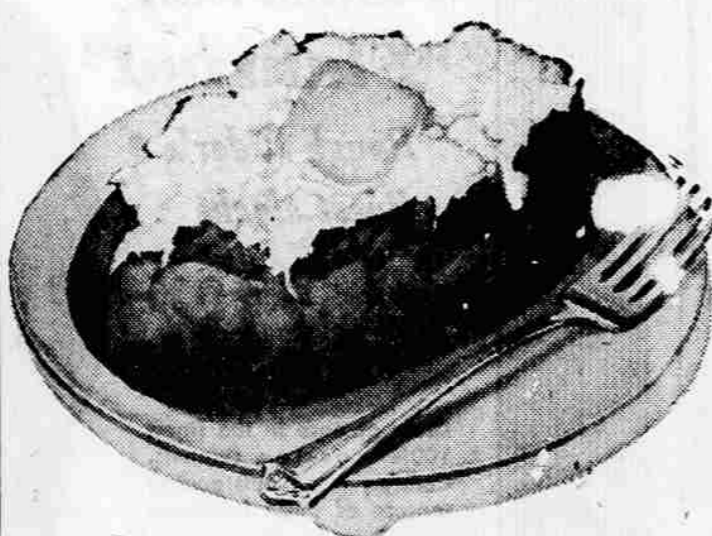
