Korngold, of New York City, have traced the so-called rheumatoid factor — found in the blood of patients with this disease — into two types of cells, one in the membrane that lines the inside of joints, and the other in lymph nodes, such as one finds in the side of the neck. It is suggestive that these lymph nodes enlarge in some cases of rheumatoid arthritis. What is hoped now is that more study of the rheumatoid factor will lead us to a better understanding of this great scourge of the human race. 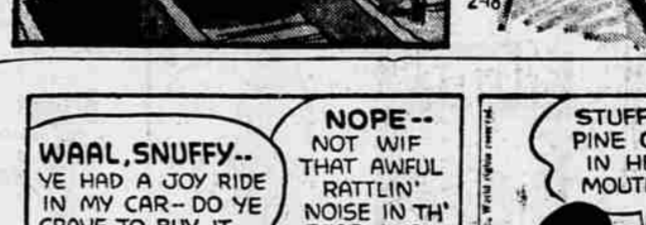
