The British seized control of Egypt and many other areas. The British colonies in Australia were federated into a self-governing state.

It was during Victoria's reign that the British Empire came to its fullest flower.

**Theater Man Has Yet To See Movie**

**Few Drug Addicts Found in Alaska**

Anchorage, Alaska —UPI—An official of the Alaska State Police reports that the 49th state has one of the lowest incidences of narcotics addiction per unit of population in the United States.

Police Lt. Larry Mayfield said Alaska has no real problem with illegal drugs except for "an occasional headhead."
