

UN Chapter Says Movie Offers Opportunity to Learn Warfare Facts

Officers of Medford chapter, Oregon United Nations association, Friday pointed out that the movie, "On the Beach," now playing at the Craterian theater, presents an opportunity for citizens "to learn facts about hydrogen bombs and nuclear warfare."

A chapter statement reads: "The facts about hydrogen bombs and nuclear warfare have been presented by Medford chapter, Oregon United Nations association, during the last few years. Members, motivated by a deep-rooted interest in stopping the arms race, have sent letters and

resolutions to our government. "The opportunity for widespread knowledge of what will happen to us if present weapons are used has been needed. Now all citizens can learn the facts and carry them to others. The opportunity is provided by the movie, 'On the Beach,' now playing at the Craterian theater.

"It is recognized that the movie is primarily an entertainment offering, superbly dramatic and artistic, and not allied with any special pleading. However, of the film, Dr. Linus Pauling, Nobel prize winner for chemistry, has said 'It may be that some years from now we may look back and say "On the Beach" is the picture that saved the world.'
